



Separation of (Unholy Things) by the Spirit

- Hebrews 10:14 For by one offering he hath perfected for ever them that are sanctified.

- Leviticus 11:44 For I am the LORD your God: ye shall **therefore sanctify yourselves**, and ye shall be holy; for I am holy: neither shall ye defile yourselves with any manner of creeping thing that creepeth upon the earth.

Genesis 12:1 ¶Now the **LORD had said** unto Abram, Get thee out of thy country, and from thy kindred, and from thy father's house, unto a land that I will shew thee

Don't stop on the road!

Acts 7:2 And he said, Men, brethren, and fathers, hearken; The God of glory appeared unto our father Abraham, when he was in Mesopotamia, *before he dwelt in Charran*, 3 And said unto him, Get thee out of thy country, and from thy kindred, and come into the land which I shall shew thee.

- Genesis 11:31 And Terah took Abram his son, and Lot the son of Haran his son's son, and Sarai his daughter in law, his son Abram's wife; and they went forth with them from Ur of the Chaldees, *TO GO into the land of Canaan*; and they came unto Haran, and dwelt there.

When was Abraham holy?



- Genesis 17:1 ¶And when Abram was ninety years old and nine, the LORD appeared to Abram, and said unto him, I am the Almighty God; **walk before me, and be thou perfect.**

Romans 4:17 ¶(As it is written, I have made thee a father of many nations,) before him whom he believed, even God, who quickeneth the dead, and **calleth those things which be not as though they were.**


- **THE LIGHT WAS GOOD!**




- 2 Peter 3:5 For this they willingly are ignorant of, that by the word of God the heavens were of old, **and the earth standing out of the water and in the water:**

After Separation God Uses the..... Separated Water




- Genesis 2:5 And every plant of the field before it was in the earth, and **every herb of the field** before it grew: for the **LORD God** had not caused it to rain upon the **earth**, and there was not a man to till the ground.
- **6 But there went up a mist from the earth, and watered the whole face of the ground.**

Sanctification, Walking in Separation

- Knowledge of Him (Separated from Ignorance)
 - Proverbs 3:6 In all thy ways acknowledge him, and he shall direct thy paths.
- Separated from the Profane
 - John 17:16 They are not of the world, even as I am not of the world.
- Separated from our old nature
 - Ephesians 4:22 That ye put off concerning the former conversation the old man, which is corrupt according to the deceitful lusts;

Sanctification the path to holiness!



1 John 5:8 And there are three that bear witness in earth, the Spirit, and the water, and the blood: and these three agree in one.

The Spirit , Obedience and the Soul!




- Ephesians 1:13 In whom ye also trusted, after that ye heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation: in whom also after that ye believed, ye were **sealed with that holy Spirit** of promise,
- Ephesians 4:30 And grieve not the holy Spirit of God, **whereby ye are sealed unto the day of redemption.**

The Soul is Set apart Sealed, Sanctified!

Sanctification of Soul :

The work of the Spirit



- 1 Peter 1:22 Seeing ye have purified your souls in obeying the truth through the Spirit unto unfeigned love of the brethren, see that ye love one another with a pure heart fervently:
- John 17:17 Sanctify them through thy truth: thy word is truth.

Sanctification of the Body: The Water & the Blood



- John 13:10 Jesus saith to him, He that is washed needeth not save to wash his feet, but is clean every whit: and ye are clean, but not all.
- John 15:3 Now ye are clean **through the word** which I have spoken unto you.

Sanctified by the word (the spiritual water for the Body)



Ezekiel 36:25 ¶Then will I
sprinkle clean water upon
you, and ye shall be clean:
from all your filthiness, and
from all your idols, will I
cleanse you.


- Ephesians 5:26 That he might sanctify and cleanse it with the washing of water by the word,
- 1 John 5:6 ¶This is he that came by water and blood, even Jesus Christ; not by water only, but by water and blood. And it is the Spirit that beareth witness, because the Spirit is truth.

Sanctification of the Heart(the inner man)



- 1 John 1:7 But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship one with another, and the blood of Jesus Christ his Son cleanseth us from all sin.
- Hebrews 10:22 Let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, **having our hearts sprinkled from an evil conscience,** and our bodies washed with pure water.

Starting the Journey




