John 4:35 Say not ye, There are yet four months, and then cometh harvest? behold, I say unto you, Lift up your eyes, and look on the fields; for they are white already to harvest.

The Rapture “Catching Away”

- John 14:3 And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again, and receive you unto myself; that where I am, there ye may be also.
- Mark 13:29 So ye in like manner, when ye shall see these things come to pass, know that it is nigh, even at the doors.
- 32 But of that day and that hour knoweth no man, no, not the angels which are in heaven, neither the Son, but the Father.
- 33 Take ye heed, watch and pray: for ye know not when the time is.

The Rapture “Catching Away”

- Mark 13:34 For the Son of man is as a man taking a far journey, who left his house, and gave authority to his servants, and to every man his work, and commanded the porter to watch.
- 35 Watch ye therefore: for ye know not when the master of the house cometh, at even, or at midnight, or at the cockcrowing, or in the morning:
- 36 Lest coming suddenly he find you sleeping.

The Rapture “The Catching Away”

- Matthew 24:30 And then shall appear the sign of the Son of man in heaven: and then shall all the tribes of the earth mourn, and they shall see the Son of man coming in the clouds of heaven with power and great glory.
- 31 And he shall send his angels with a great sound of a trumpet, and they shall gather together his elect from the four winds, from one end of heaven to the other.

The Gardener's Plan of Harvest

- 1 Corinthians 15:51 ¶Behold, I shew you a mystery; We shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed,
- 52 In a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trump: for the trumpet shall sound, and the dead shall be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed.
- 53 For this corruptible must put on incorruption, and this mortal must put on immortality.
- 54 So when this corruptible shall have put on incorruption, and this mortal shall have put on immortality, then shall be brought to pass the saying that is written, Death is swallowed up in victory.

The Rapture “The Wheat Harvest”

- Matthew 13:27 So the servants of the householder came and said unto him, Sir, didst not thou sow good seed in thy field? from whence then hath it tares?
- 30 Let both grow together until the harvest: and in the time of harvest I will say to the reapers, Gather ye together first the tares, and bind them in bundles to burn them: but gather the wheat into my barn.

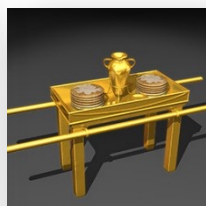

The Three Harvest Festivals

Exodus 23:14 Three times thou shalt keep a feast unto me in the year.

15 Thou shalt keep the **feast of unleavened bread**: (thou shalt eat unleavened bread seven days, as I commanded thee, in the time appointed of the month Abib; for in it thou camest out from Egypt: and none shall appear before me empty:)

16 And **the feast of harvest**, the firstfruits of thy labours, which thou hast sown in the field: and the feast of ingathering, which is in the end of the year, when thou hast gathered in thy labours out of the field.

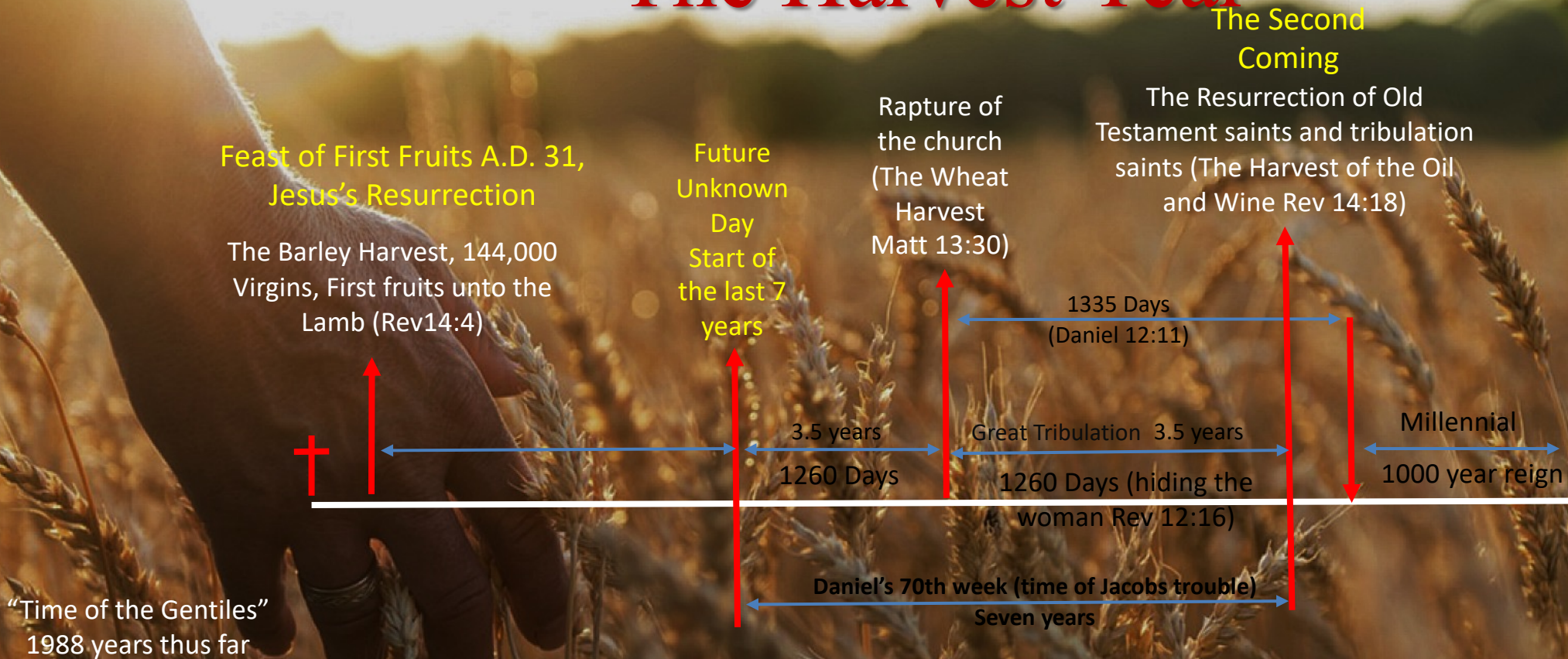
The First resurrection: The Harvest Year



Revelation 20:6 Blessed and holy is he that hath part **in the first resurrection**: on such the second death hath no power, but they shall be priests of God and of Christ and shall reign with him a thousand years.

The Harvest Year



Revelation 12:14 And to the woman were given two wings of a great eagle, that she might fly into the wilderness, into her place, where she is nourished for a time, and times, and half a time, from the face of the serpent.

Daniel 7:25 And he shall speak great words against the most High, and shall wear out the saints of the most High, and think to change times and laws: and they shall be given into his hand until a time and times and the dividing of time.

THE END OF THE FIRST
RESURRECTION



Revelation 20:4 And I saw thrones, and they sat upon them, and judgment was given unto them: and I saw the souls of them that were beheaded for the witness of Jesus, and for the word of God, and which had not worshipped the beast, neither his image, neither had received his mark upon their foreheads, or in their hands; and they lived and reigned with Christ a thousand years.

5 But the rest of the dead lived not again until the thousand years were finished. This is the first resurrection.

The “Orders”



Hebrews 7:17 For he testifieth, Thou art a priest for ever *after the order of Melchisedec.*

1 Corinthians 15:22 For as in Adam all die, even so in Christ shall all be made alive.

23 **But every man in his own order: *Christ the firstfruits;*** afterward they that are Christ's at his coming.

24 Then cometh the end, when he shall have delivered up the kingdom to God, even the Father; when he shall have put down all rule and all authority and power.

Revelation 14:4 These are they which were not defiled with women; for they are virgins. These are they which follow the Lamb whithersoever he goeth. These were redeemed from among men, *being the firstfruits unto God and to the Lamb.*

The First Fruits of the Barley



- Isaiah 26:19 **Thy dead men shall live; *together* with *my dead body*** shall they arise. Awake and sing, ye that dwell in dust: for thy dew is as the dew of herbs, and the earth shall cast out the dead.
- Matthew 27:50 ¶Jesus, when he had cried again with a loud voice, yielded up the ghost.
- 51 And, behold, the veil of the temple was rent in twain from the top to the bottom; and the earth did quake, and the rocks rent;
- 52 **And the graves were opened; and many bodies of the saints which slept arose,**
- **53 And came out of the graves** after his resurrection, and went into the holy city, and appeared unto many.

The First Fruits: Who are they ?

Jeremiah 2:3 Israel was holiness unto the LORD, and the firstfruits of his increase: all that devour him shall offend; evil shall come upon them, saith the LORD.



Revelation 7:1 ¶And after these things I saw four angels standing on the four corners of the earth, holding the four winds of the earth, that the wind should not blow on the earth, nor on the sea, nor on any tree. 2 And I saw another angel ascending from the east, having the seal of the living God: and he cried with a loud voice to the four angels, to whom it was given to hurt the earth and the sea, 3 Saying, Hurt not the earth, neither the sea, nor the trees, till we have sealed the servants of our God in their foreheads. 4 And I heard the number of them which were sealed: and there were sealed an hundred and forty and four thousands of all the tribes of the children of Israel

Who are they ?

- Revelation 7 vs 4
- “of all the tribes of the children of Israel”....
- Revelation 14 vs 3
- “Redeemed from the Earth”
- Revelation 14 vs 4
- “They are virgins”
- Revelation 14 vs 5
- “In there mouth was found no guile(Deceit) for they are without fault before the throne of God” (INNOCENTS)



The Innocent Ones!



- Matthew 2:16 ¶Then Herod, when he saw that he was mocked of the wise men, was exceeding wroth, and sent forth, **and slew all the children that were in Bethlehem, and in all the coasts thereof, from two years old and under**, according to the time which he had diligently enquired of the wise men.
- 17 Then was fulfilled that which was spoken by Jeremy the prophet, saying,
- 18 In Rama was there a voice heard, lamentation, and weeping, and great mourning, **Rachel weeping for her children**, and would not be comforted, because they are not.

Who Shall Declare His Generation!

A whole generation was wiped out by Herod



Hosea 9:16 Ephraim is smitten, their root is dried up, they shall bear no fruit: yea, though they bring forth, yet will I slay even the beloved fruit of their womb.

Isaiah 53:7 He was oppressed, and he was afflicted, yet he opened not his mouth: he is brought as a lamb to the slaughter, and as a sheep before her shearers is dumb, so he openeth not his mouth. 8 He was taken from prison and from judgment: and **who shall declare his generation?** For he was cut off out of the land of the living: for the transgression of my people was he stricken.

The Prophecy



- Genesis 30:2 And Jacob's anger was kindled against Rachel: and he said, Am I in God's stead, **who hath withheld from thee the fruit of the womb?**
- Jeremiah 31:15 thus saith the LORD; A voice was heard in Ramah, lamentation, and bitter weeping; **Rachel weeping for her children refused to be comforted for her children, because they were not.**

Our God is NEVER Defeated !



- Jeremiah 31:16 Thus saith the LORD; Refrain thy voice from weeping, and thine eyes from tears: for thy work shall be rewarded, saith the LORD; **and they shall come again from the land of the enemy.(Death/The Grave)**
- 17 And there is hope **in thine end**, saith the LORD, **that thy children shall come again to their own border.**

Romans 11:15 For if the casting away of them be the reconciling of the world, what shall the receiving of them be, but life from the dead? 16 **For if the first fruit be holy, the lump is**

Salvation for the Church



- 1 Thessalonians 4:16 For the Lord himself shall descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump of God: and **the dead in Christ shall rise first:**
- Romans 6:3 Know ye not, that so many of us as were **baptized into Jesus Christ were baptized into his death?**
- 4 Therefore we are buried with him by baptism into death: that like as Christ was raised up from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life.
- 5 For **if we have been planted** together in the likeness of his death, **we shall be also in the likeness of his resurrection:**

The middle of the feast



- John 7:10 But when his brethren were gone up, then went he also up unto the feast, not openly, *but as it were in secret.*
- 11 Then the Jews sought him at the feast, and said, Where is he?

John 7:14 ¶ Now about the *midst of the feast* Jesus went up into the temple, and taught.

The Time of Reaping!



Revelation 12:9 And the great dragon was cast out, that old serpent, called the Devil, and Satan, which deceiveth the whole world: he was cast out into the earth, and his angels were cast out with him. 10 And I heard a loud voice saying in heaven, Now is come salvation, and strength, and the kingdom of our God, and the power of his Christ: for the accuser of our brethren is cast down, which accused them before our God day and night.

Revelation 12:12 ¶Therefore rejoice, ye heavens, and ye that dwell in them. Woe to the inhabitants of the earth and of the sea! for the devil is come down unto you, having great wrath, because he knoweth that he hath but a short time.

1 Thessalonians 4:14 For if we believe that Jesus died and rose again, even so them also which sleep in Jesus will God bring with him.

“The Last Day” Is for Israel!



- John 6:39 And this is the Father's will which hath sent me, that of all which he hath given me I should lose nothing, but should **raise it up again at the last day.**
- John 6:40 And this is the will of him that sent me, that every one which seeth the Son, and believeth on him, may have everlasting life: **and I will raise him up at the last day.**
- John 6:44 No man can come to me, except the Father which hath sent me draw him: **and I will raise him up at the last day.**
- John 6:54 Whoso eateth my flesh, and drinketh my blood, hath eternal life; **and I will raise him up at the last day.**
- John 11:24 Martha saith unto him, I know that he shall rise again **in the resurrection at the last day.**

The Rapture is for the Church



1 Thessalonians 4:13 ¶But I would not have you to be ignorant, brethren, concerning them which are asleep, that ye sorrow not, even as others which have no hope.

14 For if we believe that Jesus died and rose again, even so them also which sleep in Jesus will God bring with him.

15 For this we say unto you by the word of the Lord, that we which are alive and remain unto the coming of the Lord shall not prevent them which are asleep.

16 For the Lord himself shall descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump of God: and the dead in Christ shall rise first:

17 Then we which are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds, to meet the Lord in the air: and so shall we ever be with the Lord.
