



The Steps to Salvation



• Repentance

- Hearing and then believing the Gospel Message
- A recognition that we are sinners (Confession)
- That we cannot save ourselves (Asking for forgiveness)
- That without Christ we are destined for the death of our souls.
- Recognizing the love shown by God through Christ, in coming to provide a means for reconciling us to himself.
- Understanding what God did because of Love
- Fruit of repentance "Godly sorrow"
- And a desire to change


Steps to Salvation: Hear Then Believe

t am hot ashamed of the Gospel for it is the Power of God that brings salvation to everyone who believes. Romans 1:16

KOMANS T:LO

- Romans 10:14 How then shall they call on him in whom they have not believed? and how shall they believe in him of whom they have not heard? and how shall they hear without a preacher?
- Matthew 12:41 The men of Nineveh shall rise in judgment with this generation, and shall condemn it: because they repented at the preaching of Jonas; and, behold, a greater than Jonas is here.
- Hebrews 11:6 But without faith it is impossible to please him: for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and that he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him.

Steps To Salvation: Confession



- A recognition that we are sinners (Confession)
- 1 John 1:8 ¶If we say that we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us.
- 9 If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
- 10 If we say that we have not sinned, we make him a liar, and his word is not in us.
- Psalms 32:5 I acknowledged my sin unto thee, and mine iniquity have I not hid. I said, I will confess my transgressions unto the LORD; and thou forgavest the iniquity of my sin.

We Cannot Save Ourselves!

Hand you He hade alive who were dead in trespasses and sins. Ephesians 21

- Ephesians 2:1 ¶And you hath he quickened, who were dead in trespasses and sins;
- 8 For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that NOT OF YOURSELVES: it is the gift of God:
- 9 Not of works, lest any man should boast.
- Colossians 2:13 ¶And you, being dead in your sins and the uncircumcision of your flesh, hath he quickened together with him, having forgiven you all trespasses;
- 14 Blotting out the handwriting of ordinances that was against us, which was contrary to us, and took it out of the way, nailing it to his cross;

Without Christ... Death of the Soul

"Hell itself has for its fiercest flame the separation of the soul from God."

- Psalms 86:13 For great is thy mercy toward me: and thou hast delivered my soul from the lowest hell.
- Matthew 10:28 And fear not them which kill the body, but are not able to kill the soul: but rather fear him which is able to destroy both soul and body in hell.
- Ezekiel 18:4 Behold, all souls are mine; as the soul of the father, so also the soul of the son is mine: the soul that sinneth, it shall die.

Recognizing Gods Love



- Luke 19:41 ¶And when he was come near, he beheld the city, and wept over it,
- 42 Saying, If thou hadst known, even thou, at least in this thy day, the things which belong unto thy peace! but now they are hid from thine eyes.
- John 3:16 For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life.
- 17 For God sent not his Son into the world to condemn the world; but that the world through him might be saved.

The Revelation of God's Love



- 1 John 3:1 ¶Behold, what manner of love the Father hath bestowed upon us, that we should be called the sons of God: therefore the world knoweth us not, because it knew him not.
- 2 Beloved, now are we the sons of God, and it doth not yet appear what we shall be: but we know that, when he shall appear, we shall be like him; for we shall see him as he is.
- 3 And every man that hath this hope in him purifieth himself, even as he is pure.

Understanding What God did: Love In Action!

God reconciled us to Himself through Christ and gave us the ministry of reconciliation. - 2 Cor. 5:18

- 2 Corinthians 5:19 To wit, that God was in Christ, reconciling the world unto himself, not imputing their trespasses unto them; and hath committed unto us the word of reconciliation.
- Isaiah 53:5 But he was wounded for our transgressions, he was bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace was upon him; and with his stripes we are healed.
- 6 All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned every one to his own way; and the LORD hath laid on him the iniquity of us all.
- 10 ¶Yet it pleased the LORD to bruise him; he hath put him to grief: when thou shalt make his soul an offering for sin, he shall see his seed, he shall prolong his days, and the pleasure of the LORD shall prosper in his hand.

2 Corinthians 7:10 Godly Sorrow Worldy Sorrow

Godly Sorrow

- Acts 2:36 Therefore let all the house of Israel know assuredly, that God hath made that same Jesus, whom ye have crucified, both Lord and Christ.
- 37 Now when they heard this, they were **pricked in their heart**, and said unto Peter and to the rest of the apostles, Men and brethren, what shall we do?
- 2 Corinthians 7:10 For godly sorrow worketh repentance to salvation not to be repented of: but the sorrow of the world worketh death.

Godly Sorrow Produces The Desire To Change

Do not be conformed to this world, but be

by the renewal of your mind Romans 12:2

Romans 12:2

- salms 51:1 Have mercy upon me, O God, according to thy lovingkindness: according unto the multitude of thy tender mercies blot out my transgressions.
- 2 Wash me throughly from mine iniquity, and cleanse me from my sin.
- 3 For I acknowledge my transgressions: and my sin is ever before me
- 10 Create in me a clean heart, O God; and renew a right spirit within me.
- Romans 12:2 And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.

Salvation Through Obedience to Gods Love

2 CORINTHIANS 5:21

- Acts 2:37 ¶Now when they heard this, they were pricked in their heart, and said unto Peter and to the rest of the apostles, Men and brethren, what shall we do?
- 38 Then Peter said unto them, Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost.
- 39 For the promise is unto you, and to your children, and to all that are afar off, even as many as the Lord our God shall call.

Steps of Salvation: Why Baptism?




• The Blood is the covering and.....

- The Water represents the cleansing
- Psalms 51:2 Wash me thoroughly from mine iniquity, and cleanse me from my sin.
 - Psalms 51:7 ¶Purge me with hyssop, and I shall be clean: wash me, and I shall be whiter than snow.

What does Baptism do?




- If done with the Steps of TRUE Repentance It removes our past sins!
- Acts 22:10 And I said, What shall I do, Lord? And the Lord said unto me, Arise, and go into Damascus; and there it shall be told thee of all things which are appointed for thee to do.
- Acts 22:16 And now why tarriest thou? arise, and be baptized, and wash away thy sins, calling on the name of the Lord.



What does Baptism do?

- If done with the Steps of TRUE Repentance It Identifies us with Christ
- Romans 6:4 Therefore we are buried with him by baptism into death: that like as Christ was raised up from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life.
- 5 For if we have been planted together in the likeness of his death, we shall be also in the likeness of his resurrection:

Born of the water (for the flesh) Born of the spirit(for the Soul)



 John 3:5 Jesus answered, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born of water and of the Spirit, he cannot enter into the kingdom of God.

 1 Corinthians 10:2 And were all baptized unto Moses in the cloud (The Spirit) and in the sea; (The Water) • Romans 8:11 But if the Spirit of him that raised up Jesus from the dead dwell in you, he that raised up Christ from the dead shall also quicken your mortal bodies by his Spirit that dwelleth in you.



The dead in Christ shall Rise

But the Spirit CANNOT quicken (make alive) the new man if the old man is not dead The Seed has to be planted! In order for it to germinate!



1 Corinthians 15:29 Else what shall they do which are baptized for the dead (*for their own death*), if the dead rise not at all? why are they then baptized for the dead?

THIS IS THE SALVATION REASON FOR BAPTISM!

The Seed has to be planted! In order for it to germinate!



• Romans 6:5 For if we have been planted together in the likeness of his death, we shall be also in the likeness of his resurrection:

The Steps to Salvation: Baptism (Planting the Seed)

• 1 Corinthians 15:35 ¶But some man will say, How are the dead raised up? and with what body do they come?

• 36 Thou fool, that which thou sowest is <u>NOT</u> <u>QUICKENED, except it die:</u> (planted by baptism in CHRIST)

- 37 And that which thou sowest, thou sowest not that body that shall be, but bare grain, it may chance of wheat, or of some other grain:
- 38 But God giveth it a body as it hath pleased him, and to every seed his own body.

What Baptism does not do!



- Save you from attacks from the enemy.
- John 16:33 These things I have spoken unto you, that in me ye might have peace. In the world ye shall have tribulation: but be of good cheer; I have overcome the world.
- Suddenly make you rich and successful
- Matthew 16:24 ¶Then said Jesus unto his disciples, If any man will come after me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross, and follow me.
