Presumptuous Sins & Grace



Psalms 19:13 Keep back thy servant also from presumptuous sins; let them not have dominion over me: then shall I be upright, and I shall be innocent from the great transgression.

Presuming on God



- Leviticus 10:1 ¶And Nadab and Abihu, the sons of Aaron, took either of them his censer, and put fire therein, and put incense thereon, and offered strange fire before the LORD, which he commanded them not.
- **Pre sump' shun:** Assuming an action is true or permissible without biblical warrant. Nadab and Abihu assumed God would accept their incorrectly measured incense

Presuming on God



- 1 Samuel 4:3Let us fetch the ark of the covenant of the LORD out of Shiloh unto us, that, when it cometh among us, it may save us out of the hand of our enemies.
- 5 And when the ark of the covenant of the LORD came into the camp, all Israel shouted with a great shout, so that the earth rang again.
- 10 ¶And the Philistines fought, and Israel was smitten, and they fled every man into his tent: and there was a very great slaughter; for there fell of Israel thirty thousand footmen.
- 11 And the ark of God was taken; and the two sons of Eli, Hophni and Phinehas, were slain.

NUMBERS 15:30 WEB

But the soul who does anything with a high hand, whether he is home-born or a foreigner, the same blasphemeth Yahweh; and that soul shall be cut off from among his people.



"For this they

2 Peter 3:5a

- 2 Peter 3:3 ¶Knowing this first, that there shall come in the last days scoffers, walking after their own lusts,
- 4 And saying, Where is the promise of his coming? for since the fathers fell asleep, all things continue as they were from the beginning of the creation.
- 5 For this they willingly are ignorant of, that by the word of God the heavens were of old, and the earth standing out of the water and in the water:
- 6 Whereby the world that then was, being overflowed with water, perished:

Romans 1:28 And even as they did not like to retain God in their knowledge, God gave them over to a reprobate mind, to do those things which are not convenient;

A reprobate mind refers to those whom God has rejected for their purposeful rejection of Him and their continual embracing of their godless depravity, and as a result the Lord turns them over to the inevitable destructive consequences of their own vile affections and sin.

Romans 1:29 Being filled with all unrighteousness, fornication, wickedness, covetousness, maliciousness; full of envy, murder, debate, deceit, malignity; whisperers,

30 Backbiters, haters of God, despiteful, proud, boasters, inventors of evil things, disobedient to parents,

31 Without understanding, covenant breakers, without natural affection, implacable, unmerciful:

32 Who knowing the judgment of God, that they which commit such things are worthy of death, not only do the same, but have pleasure in them that do them.

Matthew 12:31 Wherefore I say unto you, All manner of sin and blasphemy shall be forgiven unto men: but the blasphemy against the Holy Ghost shall not be forgiven unto men.

King Saul's First Sin! Presumption!



- 1 Samuel 15:17 And Samuel said, When thou wast little in thine own sight, wast thou not made the head of the tribes of Israel, and the LORD anointed thee king over Israel?
- 18 And the LORD sent thee on a journey, and said, Go and utterly destroy the sinners the Amalekites, and fight against them until they be consumed.
- 19 Wherefore then didst thou not obey the voice of the LORD, but didst fly upon the spoil, and didst evil in the sight of the LORD?
- 20 And Saul said unto Samuel, Yea, I have obeyed the voice of the LORD, and have gone the way which the LORD sent me, and have brought Agag the king of Amalek, and have utterly destroyed the Amalekites.

Presumption starts with an Assumption!

PRESUMING ON GRACE;
MOCKING FORGIVENESS

Presumptuous sin cuts many ways. You can presume on the goodness of God and turn His grace into licentiousness -- assuming the mercy He gave yesterday is what He'll give today (Mark LaCour)

(Jude 1). 4 For there are certain men crept in unawares, who were before of old ordained to this condemnation, ungodly men, **turning the grace of our God into lasciviousness**, and denying the only Lord God, and our Lord Jesus Christ.

Trusting the tree Knowledge!



Proverbs 14:12 ¶There is a way which seemeth right unto a man, but the end thereof are the ways of death.

- In each case the person did what seemed right to them at the time This is the hallmark of flesh based living It is walking by sight you are relying solely on the tree knowledge.
- Judges 17:6 In those days there was no king in Israel, but every man did that which was right in his own eyes.

Presumption seeks to manipulate the outcome; faith waits patiently on the Lord.

Hebrews 6:15 And so, after he had patiently endured, he obtained the promise.

Whether it's Hagar being given to Abraham to bring about the promised seed,

Rebekah deceiving Isaac to fulfill Jacob's destiny,
Moses murdering an Egyptian to help free his brethren,
manipulation never advanced God's promises, only hindered them.

Grace Saves! **By Obedience**



- Exodus 12:12 For I will pass through the land of Egypt this night, and will smite all the firstborn in the land of Egypt, both man and beast; and against all the gods of Egypt I will execute judgment: I am the LORD.
- 13 And the blood shall be to you for a token upon the houses where ye are: and when I see the blood, I will pass over you, and the plague shall not be upon you to destroy you, when I smite the land of Egypt.

Grace: Freedom ~~to sin~~ From Sin

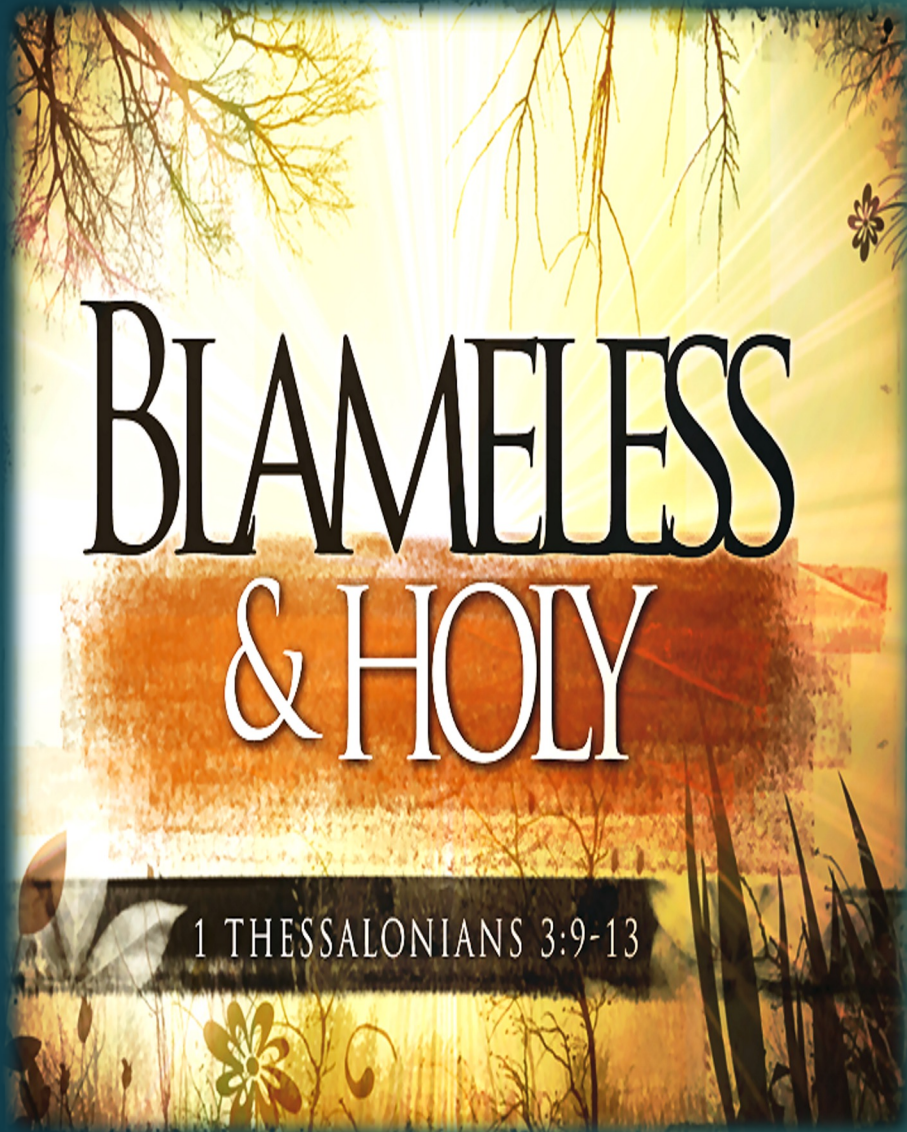


GRACE

Does Much More Abound

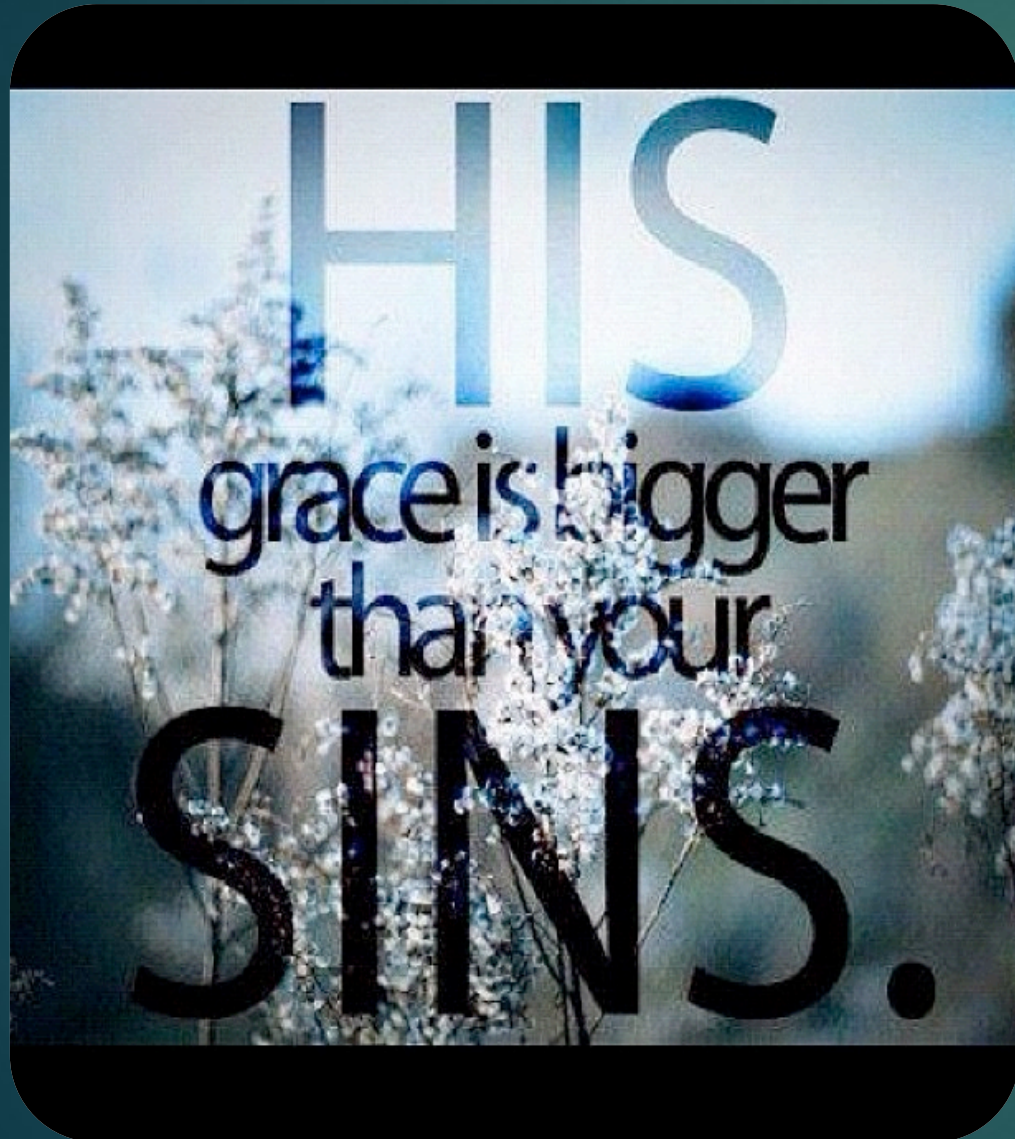
- Romans 6:1 ¶What shall we say then? Shall we **continue in sin, that grace may abound?**
- John 8:10 When Jesus had lifted up himself, and saw none but the woman, he said unto her, Woman, where are those thine accusers? hath no man condemned thee?
- 11 She said, No man, Lord. And Jesus said unto her, Neither do I condemn thee: **go, and sin no more.**
- 1 Peter 5:10 ¶But the God of all grace, who hath called us unto his eternal glory by Christ Jesus, after that ye have suffered a while, make you perfect, stablish, strengthen, settle you.

Romans 3:24 Yet now God in his gracious kindness declares us not guilty.
