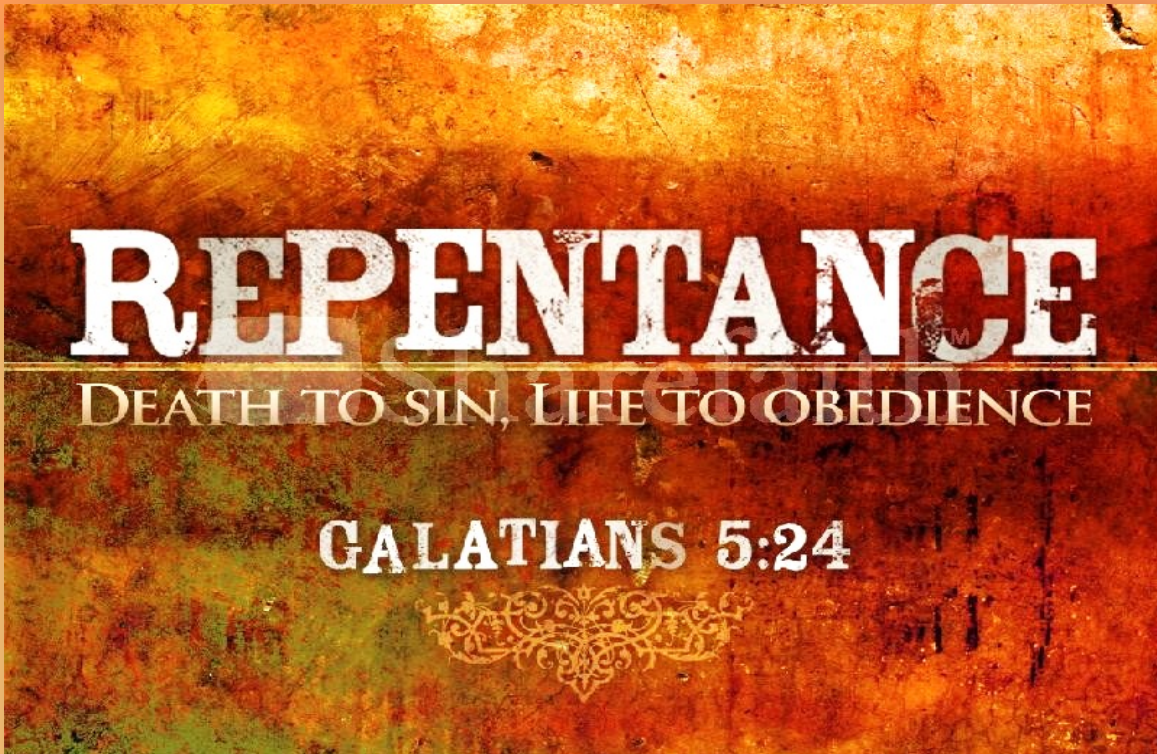

Luke 18:18 ¶ And a certain ruler asked him, saying, Good Master, **what shall I do to inherit eternal life?**

1 Thessalonians 4:1 As for other matters, brothers and sisters , **we instructed you how to live in order to please God**, as in fact you are living. Now we ask you and urge you in the Lord Jesus to do this more and more

2 For you know **what instructions we gave you by the authority of the Lord Jesus.**

3. **It is God's will that you should be sanctified:** that you should avoid sexual immorality;

4. That each of you should learn to control your own body in a way that is holy and honorable,

5. Not in passionate lust like the pagans, who do not know God;

6. And that in this matter no one should wrong or take advantage of a brother or sister. The Lord will punish all those who commit such sins, as we told you and warned you before.

7 For God did not call us to be impure, but to live a holy life.

Holiness: Walking With God

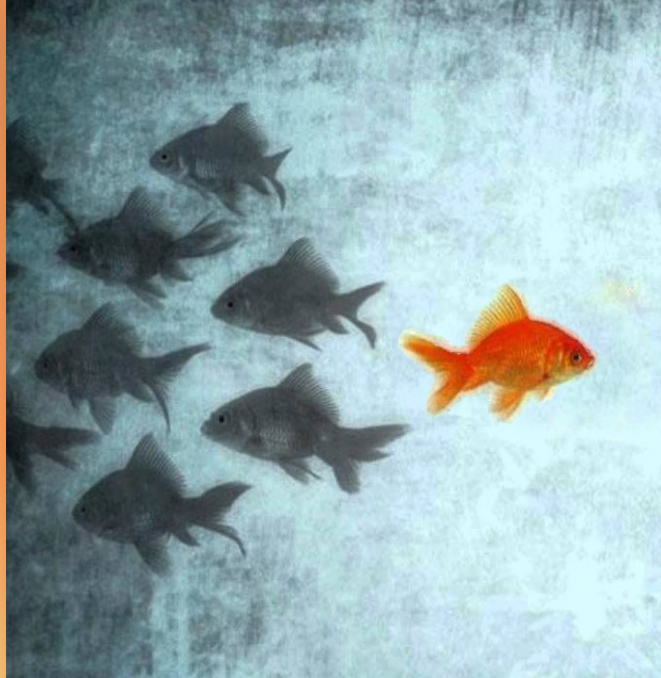


Amos 3:3 Can two walk together, except they be agreed?

Romans 1:2 And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.

John 17:12 While I was with them in the world, I kept them in thy name: those that thou gavest me I have kept, and none of them is lost, but the son of perdition; that the scripture might be fulfilled.

13 And now come I to thee; and these things I speak in the world, that they might have my joy fulfilled in themselves.

Holiness: Separation



1 Timothy 2:9

- 1 Peter 3:3 Whose adorning let it not be that outward adorning of plaiting the hair, and of wearing of gold, or of putting on of apparel;
- 1 Corinthians 11:7 For a man indeed ought not to cover his head, forasmuch as he is the image and glory of God: but the woman is the glory of the man.

Holiness: Attention to God

Not attention from men/women



2 Kings 9:30 And when Jehu was come to Jezreel, Jezebel heard of it; and she painted her face, and tired her head, and looked out at a window.

Psalms 29:2 Give unto the LORD the glory due unto his name; worship the LORD in the beauty of holiness.

Categories of teaching

- **Doctrine : Unchangeable Salvation Requirements**
 - Repentance, Baptism of water and spirit, Walking on in holiness to conform to the image of Christ.
- **Traditions(culture): Some good, Some bad**
 - Those that minister to the salvation of people who are weaker in faith so that our witness may be justified before men
- **Guidelines: As taught by the pastor**
 - Ordinances consistent with a Christian witness and to increase the respect and witness of the church in the community

Pursuing the Heart of God for the Love of the World

Proverbs 22:1 ¶A good name is rather to be chosen than great riches, and loving favour rather than silver and gold.

- 1 Timothy 3:7 Moreover he **must have a good report** of them which are without; lest he fall into reproach and the snare of the devil.
- 7 He must also have **a good reputation** with outsiders, so that he will not fall into disgrace and into the devil's trap. (NIV)

Doctrine, Traditions, & Guidelines

• *Traditions: Outward works, Justify us before men*

- Matthew 5:16 Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father which is in heaven.

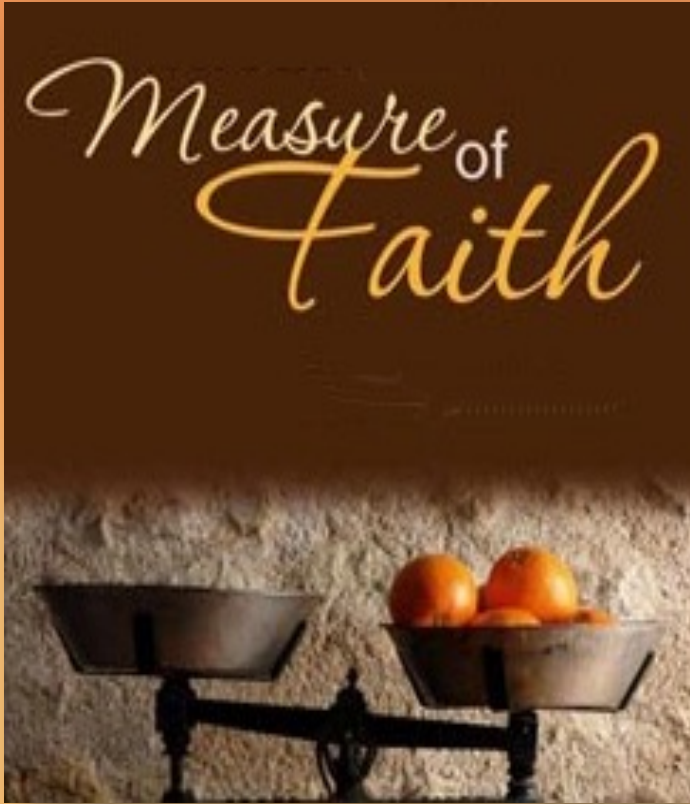
• *Faith: A sincere heart , justifies us before God.*

- Galatians 2:16 Knowing that a man is not justified (before God) by the works of the law, but by the faith of Jesus Christ, even we have believed in Jesus Christ, that we might be justified by the faith of Christ, and not by the works of the law: for by the works of the law shall no flesh be justified.

So why do different pastors have different “ordinances”

- Why are there so many different denominations ? Even that believe the same salvation message?
- 1 Corinthians 12:5 And there are *differences of administrations*, but the same Lord.

The reason is the amount of Faith!



Romans 12:3 For I say, through the grace given unto me, to every man that is among you, not to think of himself more highly than he ought to think; but to think soberly, according as ***God hath dealt to every man the measure of faith.***



1 Corinthians 8:4 ¶As concerning therefore the eating of those things that are offered in sacrifice unto idols, we know that an idol is nothing in the world, and that

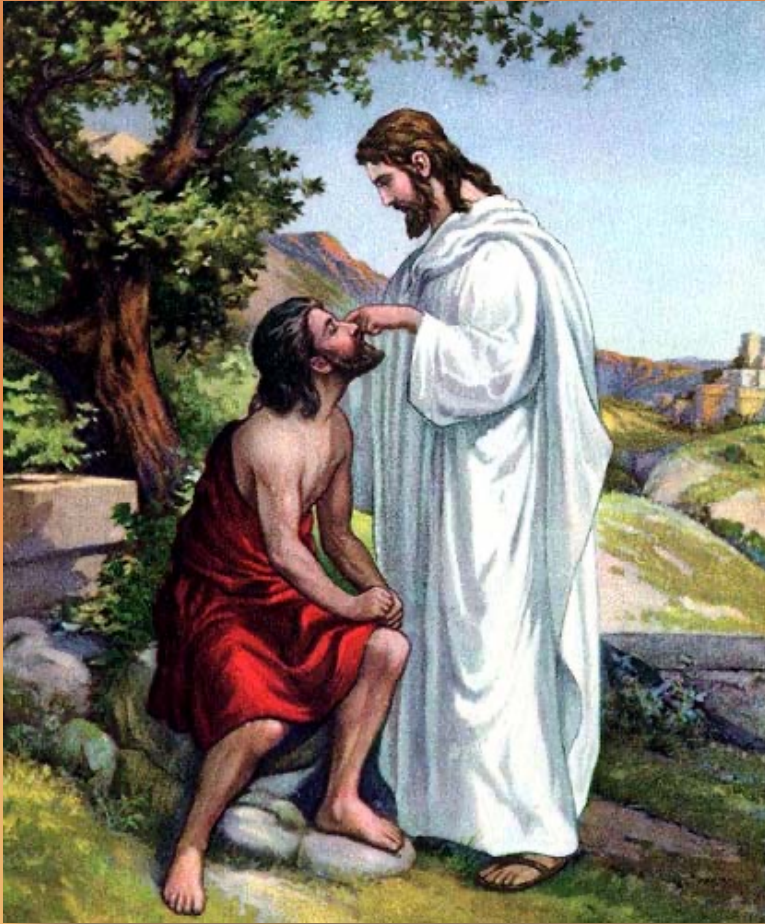
there is none other God but one. 5 For though there be that are called gods, whether in heaven or in earth, (as there be gods many, and lords many,)

- 6 But to us there is but one God, the Father, of whom are all things, and we in him; and one Lord Jesus Christ, by whom are all things, and we by him.
- 7 ¶ **Howbeit there is not in every man that knowledge:** for some with conscience of the idol unto this hour eat it as a thing offered unto an idol; and their conscience being weak is defiled.
- 8 But meat commendeth us not to God: for neither, if we eat, are we the better; neither, if we eat not, are we the worse.



- 9 But take heed lest by any means this liberty of yours become a *stumblingblock* to them that are weak.
- 10 For if any *man see thee which hast knowledge* sit at meat in the idol's temple, shall not the conscience of him which is weak be emboldened to eat those things which are offered to idols;
- 11 And through thy knowledge shall the weak brother perish, for whom Christ died?

Some need more, to see!



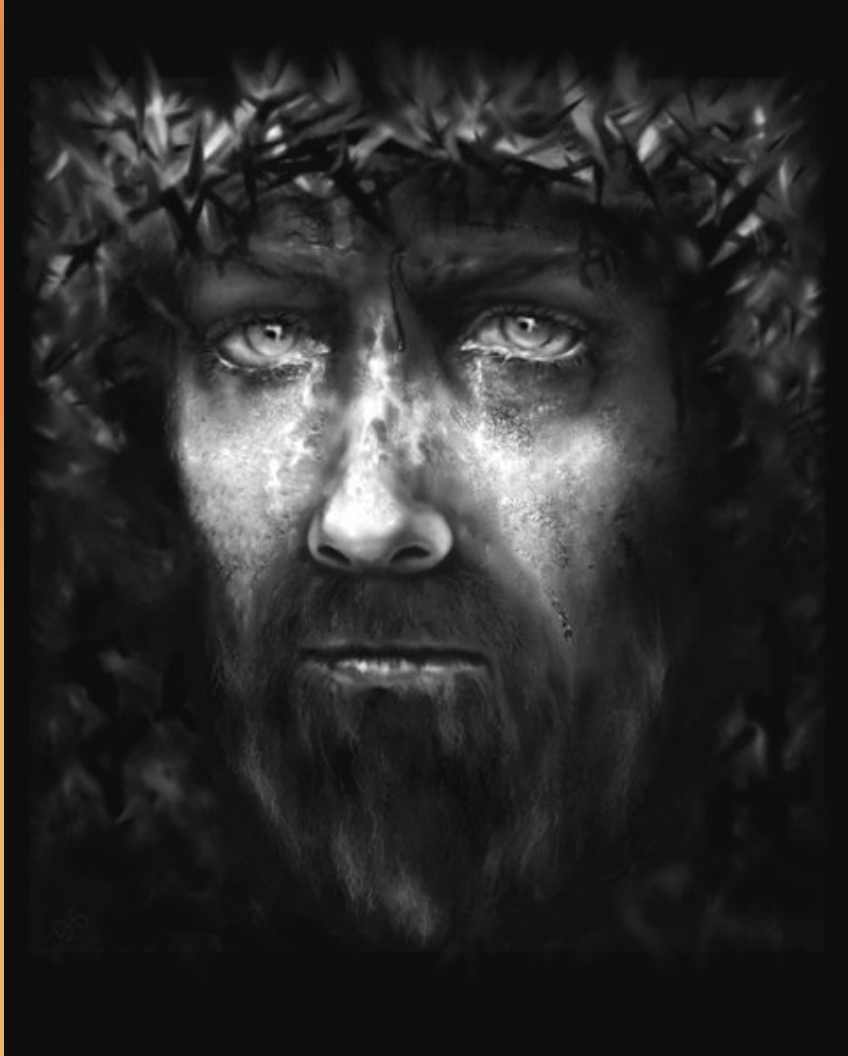
- Mark 8:22 ¶ And he cometh to Bethsaida; and they bring a blind man unto him, and besought him to touch him.
- 23 And he took the blind man by the hand, and led him out of the town; and when he had spit on his eyes, and put his hands upon him, he asked him if he saw ought.
- 24 And he looked up, and said, I see men as trees, walking.
- 25 After that he put his hands again upon his eyes, and made him look up: and he was restored, and saw every man clearly.




Hebrews 12:14 Follow peace with all men, and holiness, without which no man shall see the Lord:

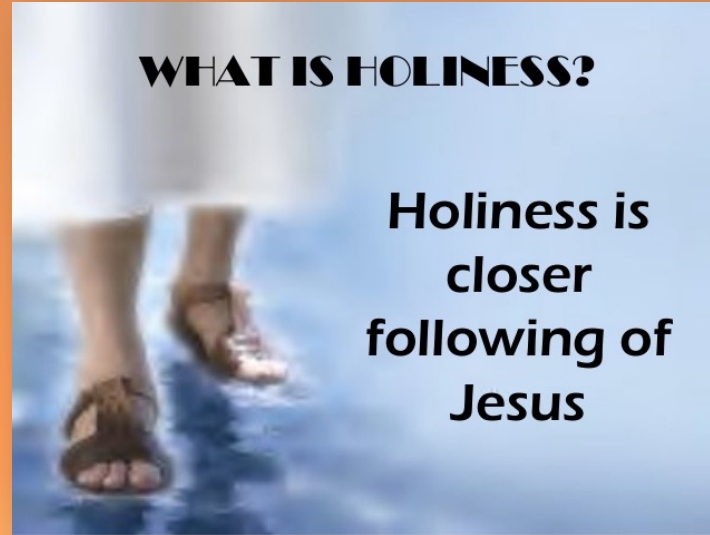
