The Old Testament Solution

Burnt Offering

“All I am Belongs to God”

Leviticus 1:3-17



Burnt offering: For the removal of Guilt towards GOD.

JUSTIFICATION

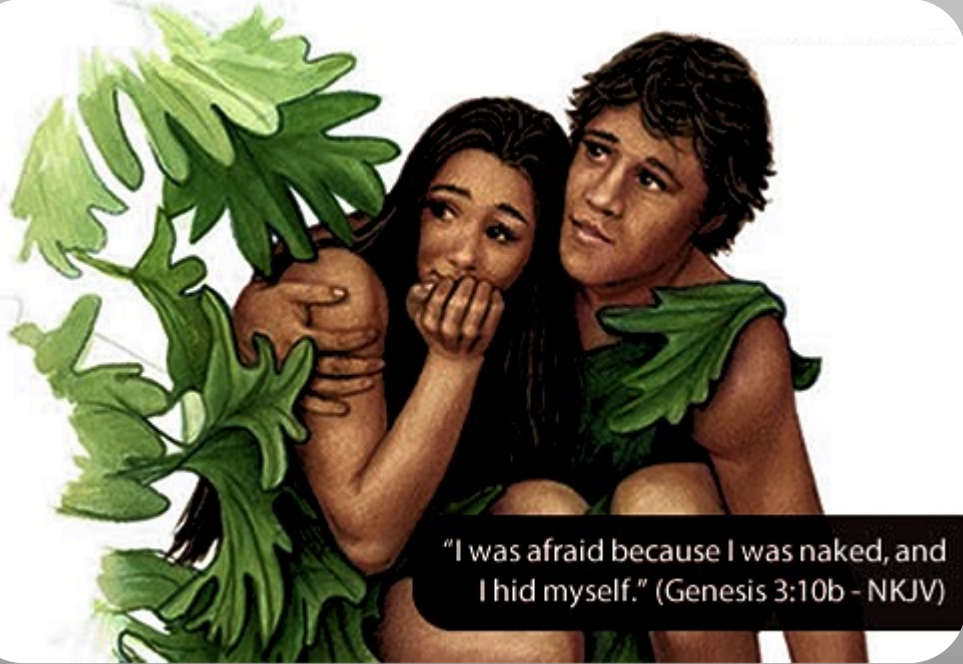
Sin offering: For forgiveness of **Unintentional** Sin against GOD.

ATONEMENT

Trespass offering: Removal of Sins(any kind) against our fellow man

FORGIVENESS

The Removal of Guilt! Consecration Requires a Covering!

Genesis 3:21 ¶Unto Adam also and to his wife did the **LORD God make coats of skins and clothed them.**

- Genesis 3:7 And the eyes of them both were opened, and they knew that they were naked; and they sewed fig leaves together and made themselves aprons.
- 8 And they heard the voice of the LORD God walking in the garden in the cool of the day: and Adam and his wife hid themselves from the presence of the LORD God amongst the trees of the garden.
- 9 ¶And the LORD God called unto Adam, and said unto him, Where art thou?
- 10 And he said, I heard thy voice in the garden, and I was afraid, because I was naked; and I hid myself.

The offering that Justifies (and Covers) :The Burnt Offering

Justification by faith (Belief: Our part)

Justification by Grace (The gift: Gods part)

- Justification by faith (Our part)
 - Romans 5:1 - Therefore being **justified by faith**, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ:
- Justification by Grace (Gods part)
 - Titus 3:7 - That being **justified by his grace**, we should be made heirs according to the hope of eternal life.

Burnt Offering: Part 1

For the removal of Guilt towards GOD: JUSTIFICATION



- Leviticus 1:4 **And he shall put his hand upon the head of the burnt offering;** and it shall be accepted for him to make atonement for him.
- 5 And he shall kill the bullock before the LORD: and the priests, Aaron's sons, shall **bring the blood,** and sprinkle the blood round about upon the altar that is by the door of the tabernacle of the congregation.

For the removal of Guilt towards GOD: JUSTIFICATION



- Leviticus 7:8 And the priest that offereth any man's burnt offering, even the priest shall have to himself the skin of the burnt offering which he hath offered.

His Part: Grace

The Burnt(and Sin) Offering for the Nation



- Exodus 29:38 ¶ Now this is that which thou shalt offer upon the altar; **two lambs of the first-year day by day continually.**
- 39 The one lamb thou shalt offer in the morning; and the other lamb thou shalt offer at even:
- **a continual burnt offering** throughout your generations at the door of the tabernacle of the congregation before the LORD: where I will meet you, to speak there unto thee.

The Morning and Evening Sacrifice



Mark 15:25 And it was the third hour, and they crucified him.

Mark 15:34 And at the ninth hour Jesus cried with a loud voice, saying, Eloi, Eloi, lama sabachthani? which is, being interpreted, My God, my God, why hast thou forsaken me?. 37 And Jesus cried with a loud voice, and gave up the ghost. 38 And the veil of the temple was rent in twain from the top to the bottom.

Christ Our Burnt offering:



- Exodus 29:18 And thou shalt burn the whole ram upon the altar: it is a burnt offering unto the LORD: it is a sweet savour, an offering made by fire unto the LORD.
- Ephesians 5:2 And walk in love, as Christ also hath loved us, and hath given himself for us an offering and a sacrifice to God for a sweetsmelling savour.

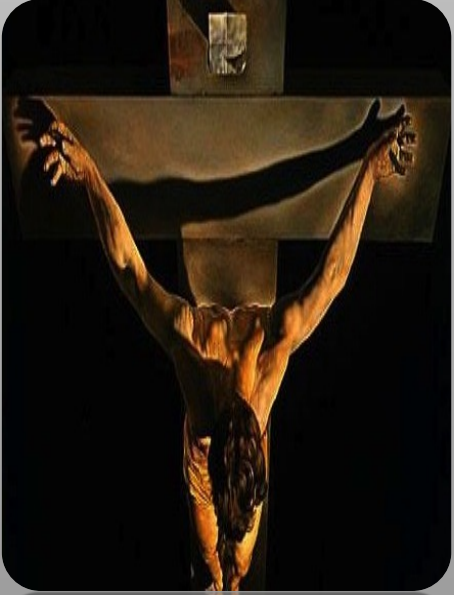
Gave his Body for our Justification(Faith in the shed blood)



- Colossians 1:21 And you, that were sometime alienated and enemies in your mind by wicked works, yet now hath he reconciled
- 22 In the body of his flesh through death, to present you holy and unblameable and unreprieveable in his sight:

Galatians 2:20 I am crucified with Christ: nevertheless I live; yet not I, but Christ liveth in me: and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by the **faith of the Son of God**, who loved me, and gave himself for me.

Gave his Spirit(SKIN) for our Justification(Covering : Grace)



Luke 23:46 And when Jesus had cried with a loud voice, he said, Father, **into thy hands I commend my spirit:** and having said thus, he gave up the ghost.

Ezekiel 37:6 And I will lay sinews upon you, and will bring up flesh upon you, and **cover you with skin, and put breath in you,** and ye shall live; and ye shall know that I am the LORD.

Isaiah 30:1 ¶Woe to the rebellious children, saith the LORD, that take counsel, but not of me; and **that cover with a covering, but not of my spirit,** that they may add sin to sin:

The Trespass/Guilt Offering (Asham)



Ram without blemish

Leviticus 6:1 ¶And the LORD spake unto Moses, saying,

2 If a soul sin, and commit a trespass against the LORD, and **lie unto his neighbour** in that which was delivered him to keep, or in fellowship, or in a thing taken away by violence, **or hath deceived his neighbour;**

3 Or have found that which was lost, and lieth concerning it, and sweareth falsely; in any of all these that a man doeth, sinning therein:

4 Then it shall be, because he hath sinned, and is guilty, that he shall restore that which he took violently away, or the thing which he hath deceitfully gotten, or that which was delivered him to keep, or the lost thing which he found,

5 Or all that about which he hath sworn falsely; he shall even restore it in the principal, and shall add the fifth part more thereto, and give it unto him to whom it appertaineth, in the day of his trespass offering.

6 **And he shall bring his trespass offering unto the LORD**, a ram without blemish out of the flock, with thy estimation, for a trespass offering, unto the priest:

Forgiveness with confession



Leviticus 5:13 And the priest shall make an atonement for him as touching his sin that he hath sinned in one of these, **and it shall be forgiven him:** and the remnant shall be the priest's, as a meat offering.

Jesus Our Trespass Offering!



Isaiah 53:10 ¶Yet it pleased the LORD to bruise him; he hath put him to grief: when thou shalt make his soul an **offering for sin(Hebrew ASHAM trespass offering)**, he shall see his seed, he shall prolong his days, and the pleasure of the LORD shall prosper in his hand.

Trespass: Forgiveness upon confession!



Colossians 2:13 ¶ And you, being dead in your sins and the uncircumcision of your flesh, hath he quickened together with him, **having forgiven you all trespasses;**

Mark 2:5 When Jesus saw their faith, **he said unto the sick of the palsy, Son,** thy sins be forgiven thee.

Luke 12:10 And whosoever shall speak a word against the Son of man, **it shall be forgiven him:** but unto him that blasphemeth against the Holy Ghost it shall not be forgiven.

Dealing with the Current Problem

Burnt offering: For the removal of Guilt towards GOD.

JUSTIFICATION

Sin offering: For forgiveness of **Unintentional** Sin against GOD.

ATONEMENT

Trespass offering: Removal of Sins(any kind) against our fellow man

FORGIVENESS

These all dealt with the current situation , day to day Living, They did not fix the problem,

THE SIN NATURE , and the death of the **SOUL!**

Changed!



- Philippians 3:21 Who **shall change our vile body**, that it may be fashioned like unto his glorious body, according to the working whereby he is able even to subdue all things unto himself.
- 2 Corinthians 3:18 But we all, with open face beholding as in a glass the glory of the Lord, are **changed into the same image from glory to glory**, even as by the Spirit of the Lord.
- 1 Corinthians 15:51 ¶Behold, I shew you a mystery; We shall not all sleep, **but we shall all be changed**,
- 1 Corinthians 15:52 In a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trump: for the trumpet shall sound, and the dead shall be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed.

Yom Ha kippurim



- 26 And the LORD spake unto Moses, saying,
- 27 Also on the tenth day of this seventh month there shall be a day of atonement: it shall be an holy convocation unto you; and ye shall afflict your souls, and offer an offering made by fire unto the LORD.
- 28 And ye shall do no work in that same day: for it is a day of atonement, to make an atonement for you before the LORD your God.

The Atonement Offering Revealed!



- Leviticus 16:15 ¶ Then shall he kill the goat of the sin offering, that is for the people, and bring his blood within the vail, and do with that blood as he did with the blood of the bullock, and sprinkle it upon the mercy seat, and before the mercy seat:
- Leviticus 16:21 And Aaron shall lay both his hands upon the head of the live goat, and confess over him all the iniquities of the children of Israel, and all their transgressions in all
- their sins, putting them upon the head of the goat, and shall send him away by the hand of a fit man into the wilderness:
- 22 And the goat shall bear upon him all their iniquities unto a land not inhabited: and he shall let go the goat in the wilderness.

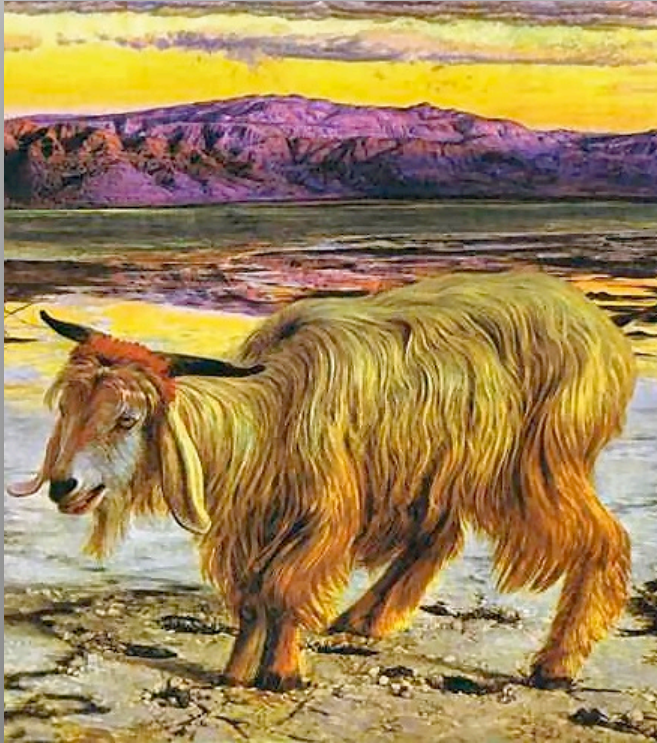

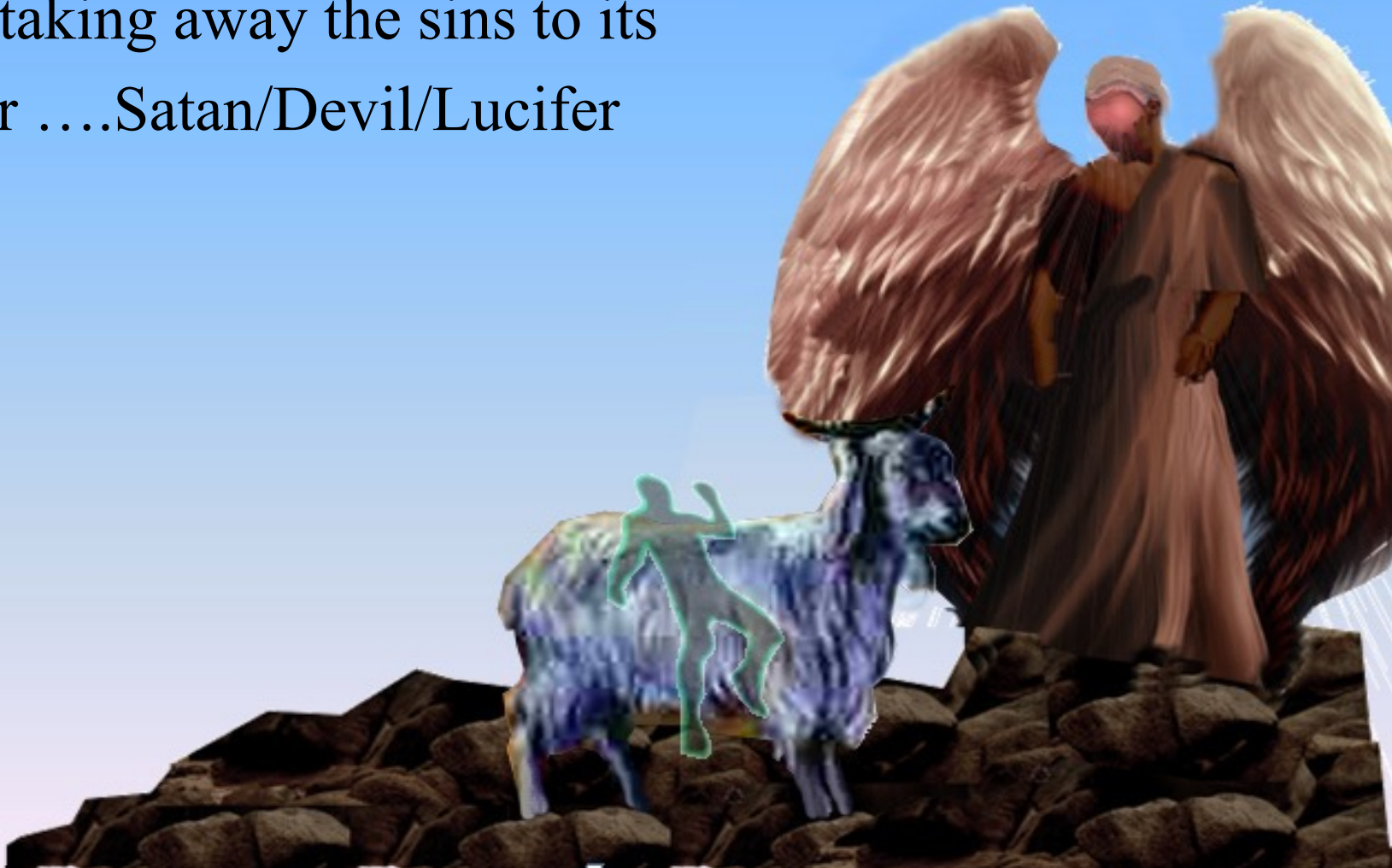

Azazel (**Hebrew**: עֲזָזֵל, *Azazel*, **Aramaic**: ܐܪܡܫܢܐܝܠ, *[citation needed]* **Arabic**: عزازيل *Azazil*) is the enigmatic name of a character in Hebrew mythology found in the **Hebrew scriptures** and **Apocrypha**. The word's first appearance is in **Leviticus 16**, where a goat is designated "for Azazel" and outcast in the desert as part of **Yom Kippur**.

He is considered by many to be a supernatural being mentioned in connection with the ritual of the **Day of Atonement** (Lev. xvi.).
