

5:11 And all the days of Enos were nine hundred and five years: and he died.


5:14 And all the days of Cainan were nine hundred and ten years: and he died.

5:27 And all the days of Methuselah were nine hundred sixty and nine years: and he died.







- Jonah 1:1 Now the word of the LORD came unto Jonah the son of Amittai, saying,




Jonah 1:17 Now the LORD had prepared a great fish to swallow up Jonah. And Jonah was in the belly of the fish three days and three nights.

2 And said, I cried by reason of mine affliction unto the LORD, and he heard me; out of the belly of hell cried I, and thou heardest my voice.


Three days and three nights!



Matthew 12:40 For as Jonas was three days and three nights in the whale's belly; so shall the Son of man be three days and three nights in the heart of the earth.


Psalms 16:9 Therefore my heart is glad, and my glory rejoiceth: my flesh also shall rest in hope.

"For this cause came I into the World"



- Matthew 26:39 And he went a little further, and fell on his face, and prayed, saying, O my Father, if it be possible, let this cup pass from me: nevertheless not as I will, but as thou wilt.
- 1 Corinthians 5:7 ¶Purge out therefore the old leaven, that ye may be a new lump, as ye are unleavened. For even Christ our passover is sacrificed for us:

Luke 23:46 And when Jesus had cried with a loud voice, he said, Father, into thy hands I commend my spirit: and having said thus, he gave up the ghost.

The Three reasons for his death

- To Release the Prisoners. (Take back the Kingdom of the grave)
 - -Isaiah 14:17 That made the world as a wilderness, and destroyed the cities thereof; that opened not the house of his prisoners?
 - -Isaiah 61:1 ¶The Spirit of the Lord GOD is upon me; because the LORD hath anointed me to preach good tidings unto the meek; he hath sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to them that are bound;

The Three reasons for his death

- To Give his blood as the temporary covering
 - Hebrews 10:4 For it is not possible that the blood of bulls and of goats should take away sins.
 - Hebrews 10:14 For by one offering he hath perfected for ever them that are sanctified.
 - Hebrews 9:14 How much more shall the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered himself without spot to God, purge your conscience from dead works to serve the living God?
 - 15 ¶And for this cause he is the mediator of the new testament, that by means of death, for the redemption of the transgressions that were under the first testament, they which are called might receive the promise of eternal inheritance.

The Three reasons for his death

- To Give his spirit as the permanent covering
 - -Romans 8:11 But if the Spirit of him that raised up Jesus from the dead dwell in you, he that raised up Christ from the dead shall also quicken your mortal bodies by his Spirit that dwelleth in you.
 - -Romans 8:9 But ye are not in the flesh, but in the Spirit, if so be that the Spirit of God dwell in you. Now if any man have not the Spirit of Christ, he is none of his.
 - -Romans 8:14 For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, they are the sons of God.

2 Chronicles 29:22


So they killed the bullocks, and the priests received the blood, and sprinkled it on the altar: likewise, when they had killed the rams, they sprinkled the blood upon the altar: they killed also the lambs, and they sprinkled the blood upon the altar.

2 Peter 2:4 For if God spared not the angels that sinned, but cast them down to hell, and delivered them into chains of darkness, to be reserved unto judgment

Leviticus 8:19 And he killed it; and Moses sprinkled the blood upon the altar round about.

The Blood was the covering ...In death! (The Spirit is the Covering NOW in Life)

For the life of a creature is in the blood, and I have given it to you to make atonement(A COVERING) for yourselves ON THE ALTAR; it is the blood that makes atonement for one's life. (Leviticus 17:11—NIV)

Not having received the promise!

- Hebrews 11:13 These all died in faith, not having received the promises, but having seen them afar off, and were persuaded of them, and embraced them, and confessed that they were strangers and pilgrims on the earth.
- 39 And these all, having obtained a good report through faith, received not the promise:
- 40 God having provided some better thing for us, that they without us should not be made perfect.

"The Better Thing"



- Hebrews 9:22 And almost all things are by the law purged with blood; and without shedding of blood is no remission.
- 23 ¶It was therefore necessary that the patterns of things in the heavens should be purified with these; but the heavenly things themselves with better sacrifices than these.
- 24 For Christ is not entered into the holy places made with hands, which are the figures of the true; but into heaven itself, now to appear in the presence of God for us:


"The better thing"


14 I will ascend above the heights of the clouds; I will be like the most High.

16 They that see thee shall narrowly look upon thee, and consider thee, saying, Is this the man that made the earth to tremble, that did shake kingdoms;


17 That made the world as a wilderness, and destroyed the cities thereof; that opened not the house of his prisoners?

- Hebrews 2:14 Forasmuch then as the children are partakers of flesh and blood, he also himself likewise took part of the same; that through death he might destroy him that had the power of death, that is, the devil;
- 15 And deliver them who through fear of death were all their lifetime subject to bondage.
- Isaiah 61:1 ¶The Spirit of the Lord GOD is upon me; because the LORD hath anointed me to preach good tidings unto the meek; he hath sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to them that are bound;

Proclaim Liberty to them that are bound!



- 1 Peter 3:18 ¶For Christ also hath once suffered for sins, the just for the unjust, that he might bring us to God, being put to death in the flesh, but quickened by the Spirit:
- 19 By which also he went and preached unto the spirits in prison;
- 20 Which sometime were disobedient, when once the longsuffering of God waited in the days of Noah, while the ark was a preparing, wherein few, that is, eight souls were saved by water.
- 21 ¶The like figure whereunto even baptism doth also now save us (not the putting away of the filth of the flesh, but the answer of a good conscience toward God,) by the resurrection of Jesus Christ:

How could he release the prisoners?



• John 19:34 But one of the soldiers with a spear pierced his side, and forthwith came there out blood and water.

Leviticus 17:11 For the life(SOUL) of the flesh is in the blood: and I have given it to you upon the altar to make an atonement(A COVERING) for your souls: for it is the blood that maketh an atonement for the soul.


The first fruits of the Wheat
