End Time Terms

- Tribulation
 - Matthew 24:29 Immediately after the tribulation of those days shall the sun be darkened, and the moon shall not give her light, and the stars shall fall from heaven, and the powers of the heavens shall be shaken:
 - Daniel 9:27 And he shall confirm the covenant with many for one week: and in the midst of the week he shall cause the sacrifice and the oblation to cease, and for the overspreading of abominations he shall make it desolate, even until the consummation, and that determined shall be poured upon the desolate.
- Great Tribulation
 - Revelation 7:14 And I said unto him, Sir, thou knowest. And he said to me, These are they which came out of great tribulation, and have washed their robes, and made them white in the blood of the Lamb.

End Time Terms

- Rapture
 - 16 For the Lord himself will come down from heaven, with a loud command, with the voice of the archangel and with the trumpet call of God, and the dead in Christ will rise first. 17 After that, we who are still alive and are left will be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air. And so we will be with the Lord forever. 18 Therefore encourage one another with these words.
- Second Coming(End of Tribulation)
 - Revelation 1:7 Behold, he cometh with clouds; and every eye shall see him, and they also which pierced him: and all kindreds of the earth shall wail because of him. Even so, Amen.
- Millennium (Thousand year reign of Christ on Earth)
 - Revelation 20:2 And he laid hold on the dragon, that old serpent, which is the Devil, and Satan, and bound him a thousand years,

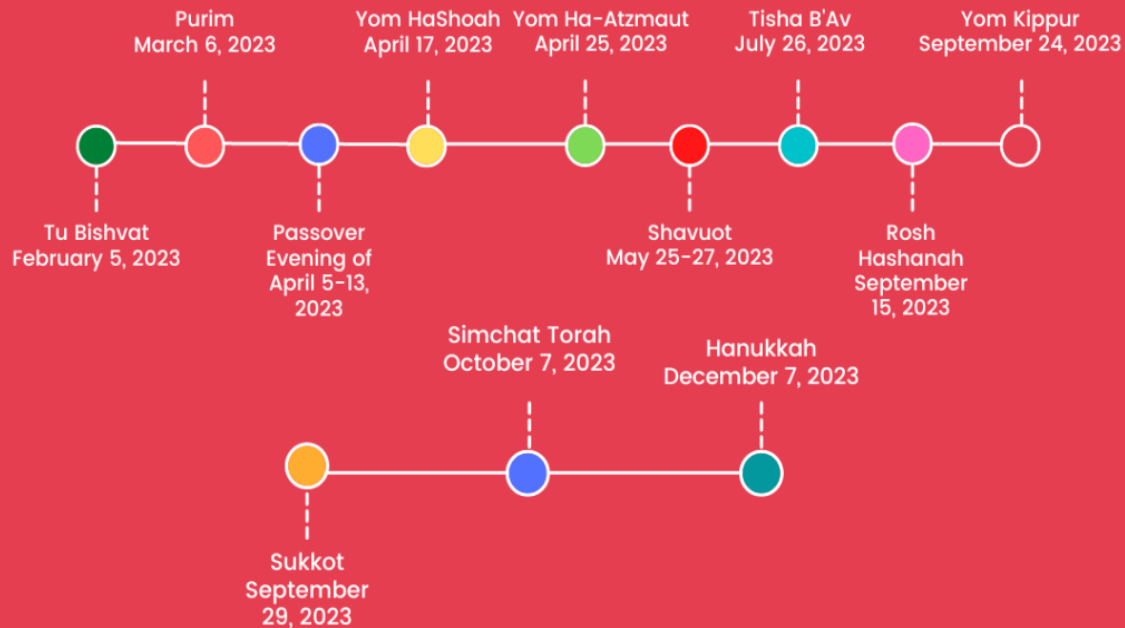
The answer to the questions

- 2 For yourselves know perfectly that the day of the Lord so cometh as a thief in the night.


: When shall these things be?



“Ye know that summer
(**The Season**) is nigh”:

- Matthew 24:32 ¶ Now learn a parable of the fig tree; When his branch is yet tender, and putteth forth leaves, ye know that summer is nigh:
- 33 So likewise ye, when ye shall see all these things, know that it is near, even at the doors.
- 34 Verily I say unto you, This generation shall not pass, till all these things be fulfilled.
- 35 Heaven and earth shall pass away, but my words shall not pass away.
- 36 **But of that day and hour knoweth no man, no, not the angels of heaven,** but my Father only.
- 37 But as the days of Noe were, so shall also the coming of the Son of man be.

.....But as in the days of Noah!



Malachi 4:1 ¶For, behold, the day cometh, that shall burn as an oven; and all the proud, yea, and all that do wickedly, shall be stubble: and the day that cometh shall burn them up, saith the LORD of hosts, that it shall leave them neither root nor branch.

- Matthew 24:37 But as the days of Noe were, so shall also the coming of the Son of man be.
- Luke 17:26 And as it was in the days of Noe, so shall it be also in the days of the Son of man.

The Days of Noah



- Genesis 6:11 ¶The earth also was corrupt before God, and the earth was filled with violence.
- 12 And God looked upon the earth, and, behold, it was corrupt; for all flesh had corrupted his way upon the earth.
- 13 ¶And God said unto Noah, The end of all flesh is come before me; for the earth is filled with violence through them; and, behold, I will destroy them with the earth.


Why does God not just tell us the exact times ?



- 1 Corinthians 2:7 But we speak the wisdom of God in a mystery, even the hidden wisdom, which God ordained before the world unto our glory:
- 8 Which none of the princes of this world knew: **for had they known it, they would not have crucified the Lord of glory.**
- Acts 1:7 And he said unto them, It is not for you to know the times or the seasons, which the Father hath put in his own power.

The Mystery of Iniquity: The Third Day



- Exodus 19:10 And the LORD said unto Moses, **Go unto the people, and sanctify them to day and to morrow, and let them wash their clothes,**
- 11 **And be ready against the third day:** for the third day the LORD will come down in the sight of all the people upon mount Sinai.
- 18 And mount Sinai was altogether on a smoke, because **the LORD descended** upon it in fire: and the smoke thereof ascended as the smoke of a furnace, and the whole mount quaked greatly.
- 19 **And when the voice of the trumpet sounded long,** and waxed louder and louder, Moses spake, and God answered him by a voice.
- 20 And the LORD came down upon mount Sinai, on the top of the mount: and **the LORD called Moses up to the top of the mount; and Moses went up.**

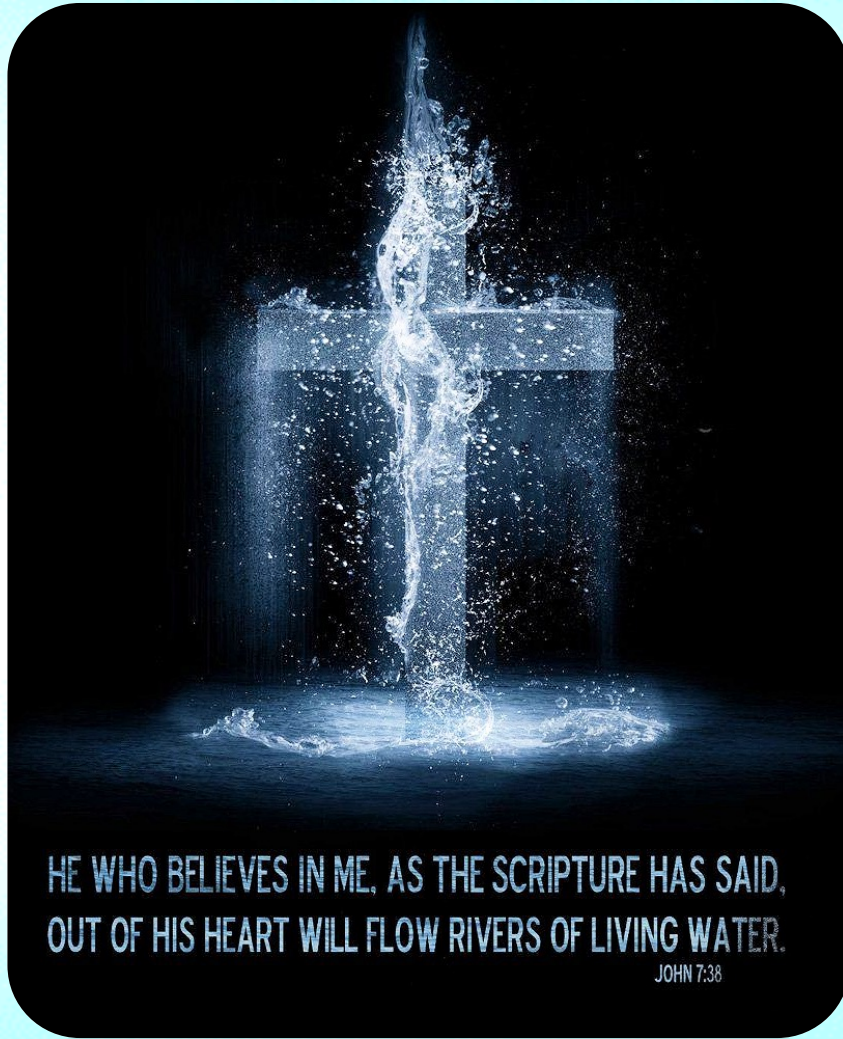


The **SUN** Dial of Ahaz.

2 Kings 20:5 Turn again, and tell Hezekiah the captain of my people, Thus saith the LORD, the God of David thy father, I have heard thy prayer, I have seen thy tears: behold, I will heal thee: **on the third day thou shalt go UP unto the house of the LORD.**

- 2 Kings 20:8 And Hezekiah said unto Isaiah, **What shall be the sign** that the LORD will heal me, and that I shall go up into the house of the LORD the third day?
- 11 And Isaiah the prophet cried unto the LORD: and he brought the shadow ten degrees backward, by which it had gone down in the dial of Ahaz.


The Mystery of Iniquity: The Third Day



- John 7:8 Go ye up unto this feast: I go not up yet unto this feast; **for my time is not yet full come.**
- 9 When he had said these words unto them, he abode still in Galilee.
- 10 But when his brethren were gone up, then went he also up unto the feast, not openly, but as **it were in secret.**
- 11 Then the Jews sought him at the feast, and said, **Where is he?**
- 14 **Now about the midst** of the feast Jesus went up into the temple, and taught.

The Mystery of Iniquity: Cycle of Three



- Matthew 17:1 ¶ **And after six days** Jesus taketh Peter, James, and John his brother, and **bringeth them UP into an high mountain apart,**
- 2 And was transfigured before them: and his face did shine as the sun, and his raiment was white as the light.
- 3 And, behold, there appeared unto them Moses and Elias talking with him.

When does it happen ?

The Wheat Harvest !



- Matthew 13:28 He said unto them, An enemy hath done this. The servants said unto him, Wilt thou then that we go and gather them up?
- 29 But he said, Nay; lest while ye gather up the tares, ye root up also the wheat with them.
- 30 Let both grow together **until the harvest:** and in the time of harvest I will say to the reapers, Gather ye together first the tares, and bind them in bundles to burn them: but **gather the wheat into my barn.**
