The Comforter



Acts 2:1 ¶And when the day of Pentecost was fully come, they were all with one accord in one place.

2 And suddenly there came a sound from heaven as of a rushing mighty wind, and it filled all the house where they were sitting.

3 And there appeared unto them cloven tongues like as of fire, and it sat upon each of them.

4 And they were all filled with the Holy Ghost, and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance.



God is Spirit

- John 4:24 God is a Spirit: and they that worship him must worship him in spirit and in truth.

John 4:23 But the hour is coming, and now is, when the true worshipers will worship the Father in spirit and truth; for the Father is seeking such to worship Him.

Gods Covering Given to man



Genesis 2:7 And the LORD God formed man of the dust of the ground, and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life; and man became a living soul.

John 20:22 And when he had said this, he breathed on them, and saith unto them, Receive ye the Holy Ghost:

Every Creature Was Given A Covering



- Psalms 91:4 He shall cover thee with his feathers, and *under his wings shalt thou trust*: his truth shall be thy shield and buckler.
- Hebrew :Wings – “Kanaph”
- “Corner or hem of Garment”

Every Creature Was Given A Covering



- Isaiah 6:1 ¶In the year that king Uzziah died I saw also the Lord sitting upon a throne, high and lifted up, and his train filled the temple.
- 2 Above it stood the seraphims: each one had six wings; *with twain he covered his face, and with twain he covered his feet*, and with twain he did fly.

Adam & Eve Lose there covering



- Genesis 3:9 ¶And the LORD God called unto Adam, and said unto him, Where art thou?
- 10 And he said, I heard thy voice in the garden, and I was afraid, because I was naked; and I hid myself.
- 11 ¶And he said, Who told thee that thou wast naked? Hast thou eaten of the tree, whereof I commanded thee that thou shouldest not eat?

But what does the spirit Do?

- John 14:16 And I will pray the Father, and he shall give you another Comforter, that he may abide with you for ever;



Holy Spirit: Teaches



- John 14:26 But the Advocate, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you all things and will remind you of everything I have said to you.

Holy Spirit: Sanctifies (Sets apart)



- 1 Corinthians 6:11 And such were some of you: but ye are washed, but ye are sanctified, but ye are justified in the name of the Lord Jesus, and by the Spirit of our God.

1 Peter 1:2 Elect according to the foreknowledge of God the Father, through sanctification of the Spirit, unto obedience and sprinkling of the blood of Jesus Christ: Grace unto you, and peace, be multiplied.

Holy Spirit: Testifies (Witnesses)



- John 15:26 ¶But when the Comforter is come, whom I will send unto you from the Father, even the Spirit of truth, which proceedeth from the Father, he shall testify of me:

Holy Spirit: Saves



- Titus 3:5 Not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to his mercy he saved us, by the washing of regeneration, and renewing of the Holy Ghost;
- 6 Which he shed on us abundantly through Jesus Christ our Saviour;

Romans 8:9 But ye are not in the flesh, but in the Spirit, if so be that the Spirit of God dwell in you. Now if any man have not the Spirit of Christ, he is none of his. 10 ¶ And if Christ be in you, the body is dead because of sin; but the Spirit is life because of righteousness.

The Sound of the Spirit



- John 3:7 Marvel not that I said unto thee, Ye must be born again.
- 8 The wind bloweth where it listeth (Wants to), and thou hearest the sound thereof, but canst not tell whence it cometh, and whither it goeth: so is every one that is born of the Spirit.



The signs



Mark 16:16 He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned.

17 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues;

18 They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.

The one common sign

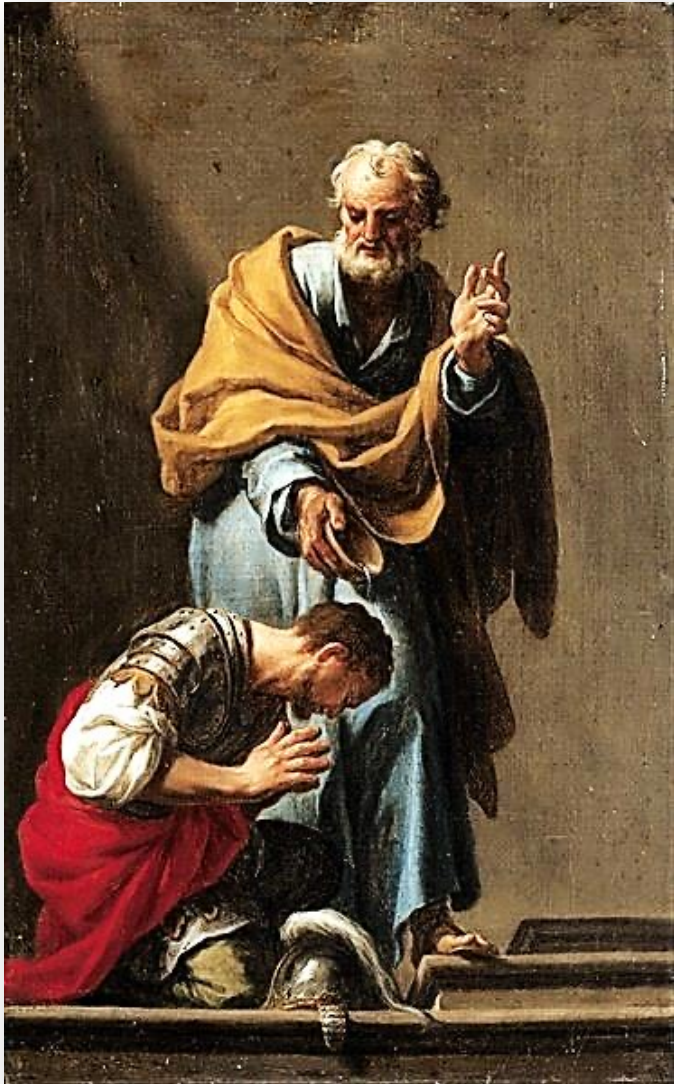

Believing is not the filling!

- Acts 8:12 But when they believed Philip preaching the things concerning the kingdom of God, and the name of Jesus Christ, they were baptized, both men and women.
- 14 ¶ Now when the apostles which were at Jerusalem heard that Samaria had received the word of God, they sent unto them Peter and John:
- 15 Who, when they were come down, prayed for them, that they might receive the Holy Ghost:
- 16 *(For as yet he was fallen upon none of them: only they were baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus.)*
- 17 *Then laid they their hands on them, and they received the Holy Ghost.*

The First Gentile



Acts 10:44 ¶While Peter yet spake these words, the Holy Ghost fell on all them which heard the word. 45 And they of the circumcision which believed were astonished, as many as came with Peter, because that on the Gentiles also was poured out the gift of the Holy Ghost. 46 For they heard them speak with tongues, and magnify God. Then answered Peter, 47 Can any man forbid water, that these should not be baptized, which have received the Holy Ghost as well as we? 48 And he commanded them to be baptized in the name of the Lord. Then prayed they him to tarry certain days

The Infilling of the spirit

How do we get it?

Acts 2:38 Then Peter said unto them, **Repent**, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost.

How do you receive the Gift?

- They Tarried (waited)
 - Acts 1:14 These all continued with one accord in prayer and supplication,.....
- They worshipped
 - Luke 24:52 And they worshipped him, and returned to Jerusalem with great joy:
 - 53 And were continually in the temple, praising and blessing God. Amen.
- By the Laying on of Hands
 - Acts 8:17 Then laid they their hands on them, and they received the Holy Ghost.
- When they heard the word
 - Acts 10:44 ¶While Peter yet spake these words, the Holy Ghost fell on all them which heard the word.

The Adoption



- John 1:12 But as many as received him, to them gave he power to become the sons of God, even to them that believe on his name:
- Romans 8:14 For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, they are the sons of God.
