





The Nature Of God "The Highest Law"



Psalms 19:7 ¶The law of the LORD is perfect, converting the soul: the testimony of the LORD is sure, making wise the simple. 8 The statutes of the LORD are right, rejoicing the heart: the commandment of the LORD is pure, enlightening the eyes. 9 The fear of the LORD is clean, enduring for ever: the judgments of the LORD are true and righteous altogether.



To study God's attributes is to study his character, to answer questions like, Who is God? and What is God like? A typical classification of God's attributes divides them into those that are incommunicable (those that he does not share or "communicate" to anyone or anything else) and (those that he shares with other beings). Like most theological classifications, this one is imperfect but still helpful as we seek to understand what is so far beyond ourselves.

God's communicable attributes can be further categorized into: attributes of God's being, mental attributes, moral attributes, attributes of purpose and "summary" attributes (attributes that, in a more particular way, modify each of the others).

It is important to consider that God is not simply the sum of his attributes. His attributes are not separate from one another, but each one modifies or qualifies each of the others.

OPEN Theism

Open Theism is the thesis that, because God loves us and desires that we freely choose to reciprocate His love, He has made His knowledge of, and plans for, the future conditional upon our actions. Though omniscient, God does not know what we will freely do in the future.


1. God Reserves The Right To Modify Or Reverse Any Of His Prophecies

There have been times in the Scriptures when God declared a certain course for the future but as a result of God observing a new free choice on the part of man, God changed His mind and reversed, modified, or cancelled His own prophecy.

Examples are: Genesis 6:5-6; Exodus 32:10-14; Jonah 3:10; Isaiah 38:1-5; Jeremiah 18:7-10.

Absolute prophecies are those in which God foretells what He Himself is planning on doing in the future. His foreknowledge in this case is based upon His own plans. <u>Examples:</u> Genesis 3:15 Isaiah 46:10-11	Conditional prophecies are those which may or may not come to pass, depending on what choices men make. <u>Examples:</u> Jeremiah 26:3 Luke 13:3, 5	Extrapolative prophecies are those in which God is able to predict the future free choice of a moral agent based upon their current character and circumstances. <u>Examples:</u> Deuteronomy 31:20-21 Acts 13:22 Matthew 26:34	Analogous or parallel fulfillments are when Scriptures are applied to a situation because of similarity, though the original passage may not have been about that specific event. <u>Examples:</u> Hosea 11:1 applied to Matt. 2:15. Ps. 41:9 applied to Jn. 13:18. Ps. 69:25 & Ps. 109:8 applied to Acts 1:20




The True Answer


Walking together signifies a covenant relationship
