

THE GIFT EVERYONE GETS! THE FIRST GIFT!




Ephesians 2:8 For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God:

Titus 2:11 For the grace of God that bringeth salvation hath appeared to all men,


Reflecting the gift: "Grace unto the hearers"



- How is Gods gift of grace manifested?
- Matthew 6:12 And forgive us our debts, as we forgive our debtors. 15 But if ye forgive not men their trespasses, neither will your Father forgive your trespasses.

Ephesians 4:29 Let no corrupt communication proceed out of your mouth, but that which is good to the use of edifying, that it may minister grace unto the hearers.

Ministering grace



1 Peter 4:10 As every man hath received the gift, even so minister the same one to another, as good stewards of the manifold grace of God.

Matthew 7:2 For with what judgment ye judge, ye shall be judged: and with what measure ye mete, it shall be measured to you again.


If you are not using the first gift? Will you be given more?

"To everyone that hath, shall be given"




Matthew 25:29 For unto every one that hath shall be given, and he shall have abundance: but from him that hath not shall be taken away even that which he hath.

Burying Gods Grace!



- Matthew 25:15 And unto one he gave five talents, to another two, and to another one; to every man according to his several ability; and straightway took his journey.
- 16 Then he that had received the five talents went and traded with the same, and made them other five talents.
- 17 And likewise he that had received two, he also gained other two.
- 18 But he that had received one went and digged in the earth, and hid his lord's money.

Burying the First Gift: Crucifying Him Again



Galatians 2:21 I do not make the grace of God of no effect: because if righteousness is through the law, then Christ was put to death for nothing.

Mark 7:13 Making the word of God of none effect through your tradition, which ye have delivered: and many such like things do ye.


The gifts are without repentance!

The Gifts and Calling of God are Without Repentance Romans 11:29

- "Charisma" Gifts:
 - Definition: a favor with which one receives without any merit of his own


- Romans 11:29 For the gifts and calling of God are without repentance.
- That is, it does not depend on our merit, but Gods favor and sovereign choices

The Other Spiritual Gifts




- 1 Corinthians 12:4 Now there are diversities of gifts, but the same Spirit.
- 5 And there are differences of administrations, but the same Lord.
- 6 And there are diversities of operations, but it is the same God which worketh all in all.

He Gives



1 Corinthians 12:7 There are different ways God works in our lives, but it is the same God who does the work through all of us. 7 A spiritual gift is given to each of us as a means of helping the entire church. 8 To one person the Spirit gives the ability to give wise advice; to another he gives the gift of special knowledge. 9 The Spirit gives special faith to another, and to someone else he gives the power to heal the sick. 10 He gives one person the power to perform miracles, and to another the ability to prophesy. He gives someone else the ability to know whether it is really the Spirit of God or another spirit that is speaking. Still another person is given the ability to speak in unknown languages, and another is given the ability to interpret what is being said. 11 It is the one and only Holy Spirit who distributes these gifts. He alone decides which gift each person should have. NLT
