shalt surely die.

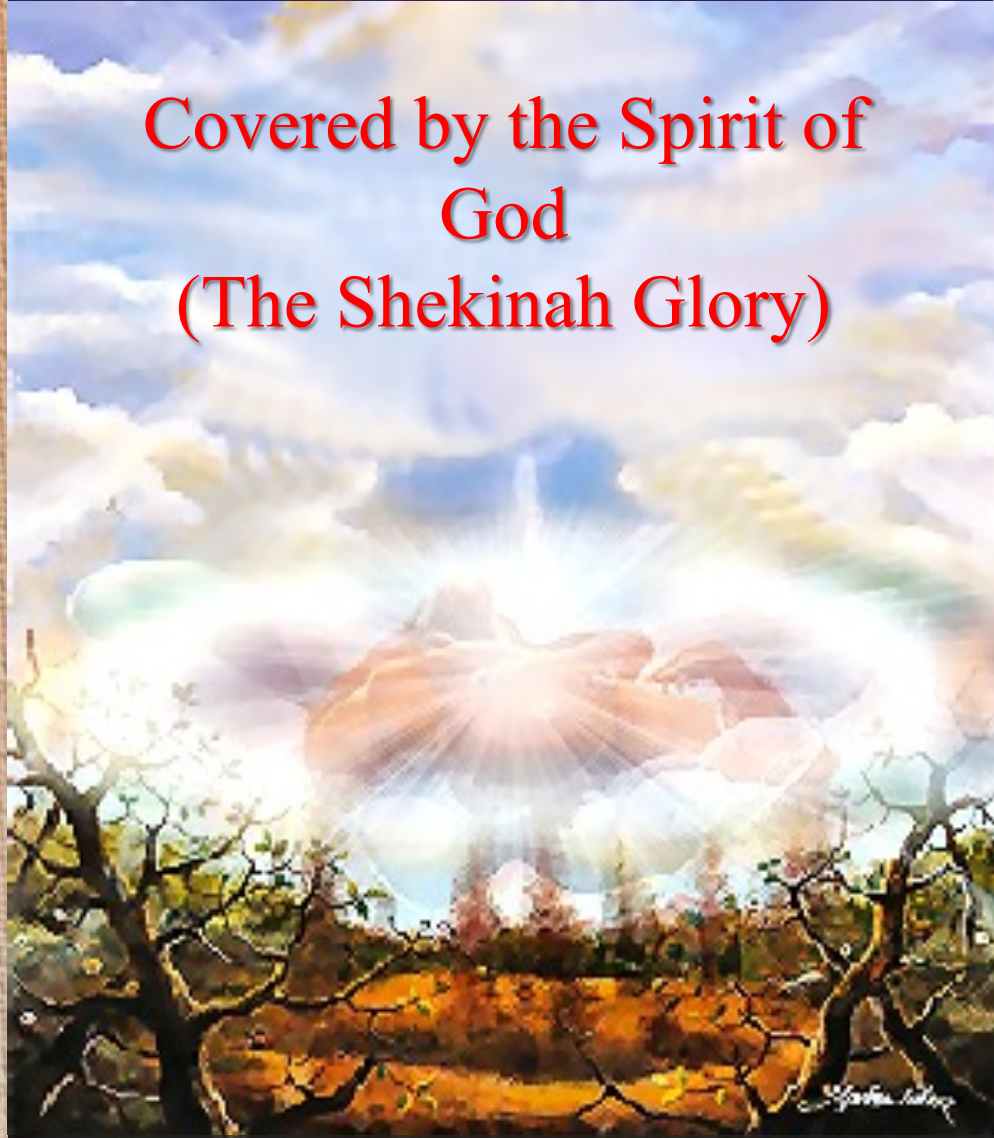
“In His Image”

- A Soul (A Spirit Being)

- Genesis 2:7 And the LORD God formed man of the dust of the ground, and

Created, Formed, Made...and



- *Created* A Soul Being
- *Formed* A Flesh Body
- *Made* “a living soul(Fleshly being)” by the incorporation of that soul in a body

The Fifth Word Of Creation

"Planted" (Hebrew , [tn, "Nata")



Genesis 2:8 ¶And the LORD God planted a garden eastward in Eden; and there he put the man whom he had formed.

What did God Plant?

Seed, “After his kind”



Genesis 1:11 And God said, Let the earth bring forth grass, **the herb yielding seed**, and the fruit tree yielding fruit **after his kind, whose seed is in itself**, upon the earth: and it was so.

The Seed Represents.....?



Matthew 13:23 But he that received seed into the good ground is he that heareth the word, and understandeth it; which also beareth fruit, and bringeth forth, some an hundredfold, some sixty, some thirty.

The seed represents **THE WORD OF GOD!**

The Seed Represents.....?



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The seed planted by God in the garden then also represents **“THE WORD OF GOD”**

The Food(word) came directly from God



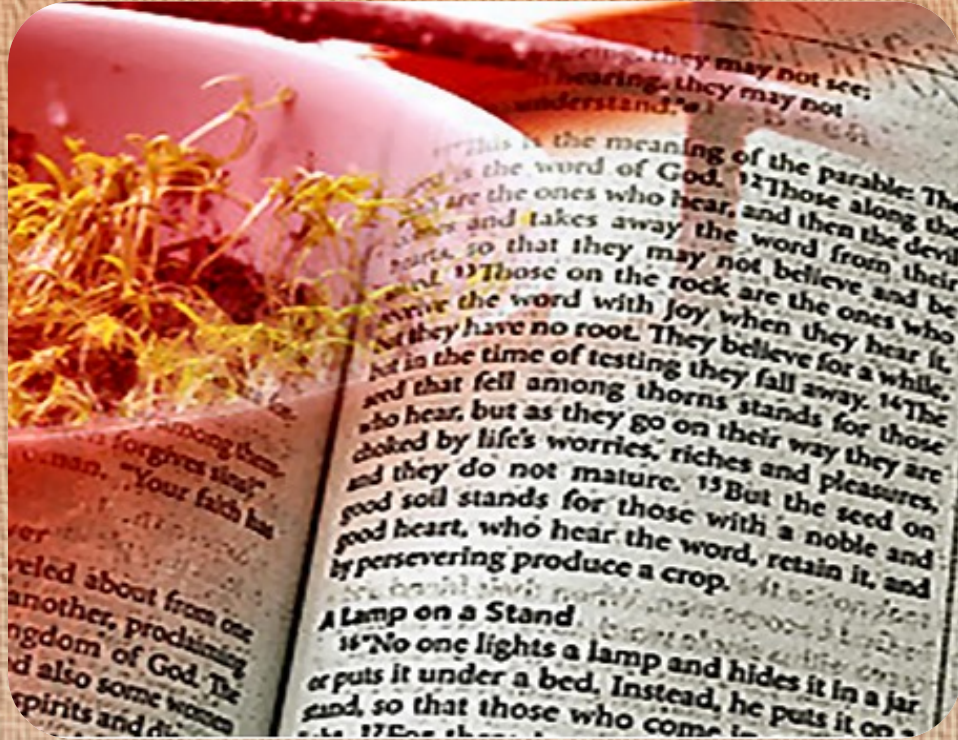

- 1 John 3:9 Whosoever is born of God doth not commit sin; **for his seed** remaineth in him: and he cannot sin, because he is born of God.
- So mans two natures body and soul, were sustained by the word of God, The body through the physical seed representing the word, and the soul , **Through the literal words (by the spirit covering) that gave breath!**

The Natural Food for the Body



Luke 4:4 And Jesus answered him, saying, It is written, That man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word of God.

- John 1:1 ¶In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.
- The Word was in the Beginning In the Garden as literal food and Spiritual food!

“by every word **that proceedeth out of
the mouth of the LORD** doth man live”

It was the very “breath of life”,
that animated the flesh body.

- *Genesis 2:7 breathed into his nostrils the
breath of life (The word comes by the breath); and
man became a living soul.*

The Seed Sown!

Corinthians 15:37 And that which thou sowest, thou sowest not that body that shall be, but bare grain, it may chance of wheat, or of some other grain: 38 But God giveth it a body as it hath pleased him, and to every seed his own body.

- Figuratively the “word”(the good seed) was planted(symbolically died), in the garden and resurrecting as the tree of life.
- It is in Christ's death we have redemption and in his resurrection, we have eternal life!



WISDOM: Proverbs 3:18 She is a tree of life to them that lay hold upon her: and happy is every one that retaineth her.

Genesis 1:12 And the earth brought forth grass, and herb yielding seed after his kind, and the tree yielding fruit, whose seed was in itself, after his kind: and **God saw that it was good.**

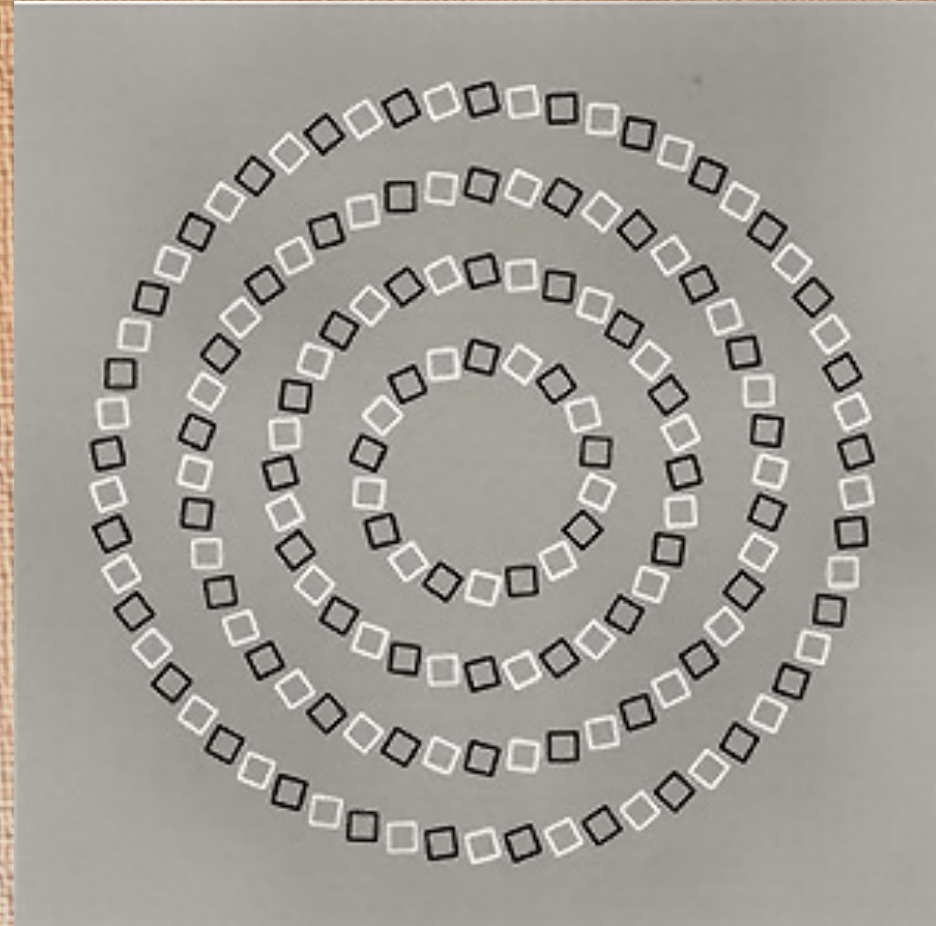
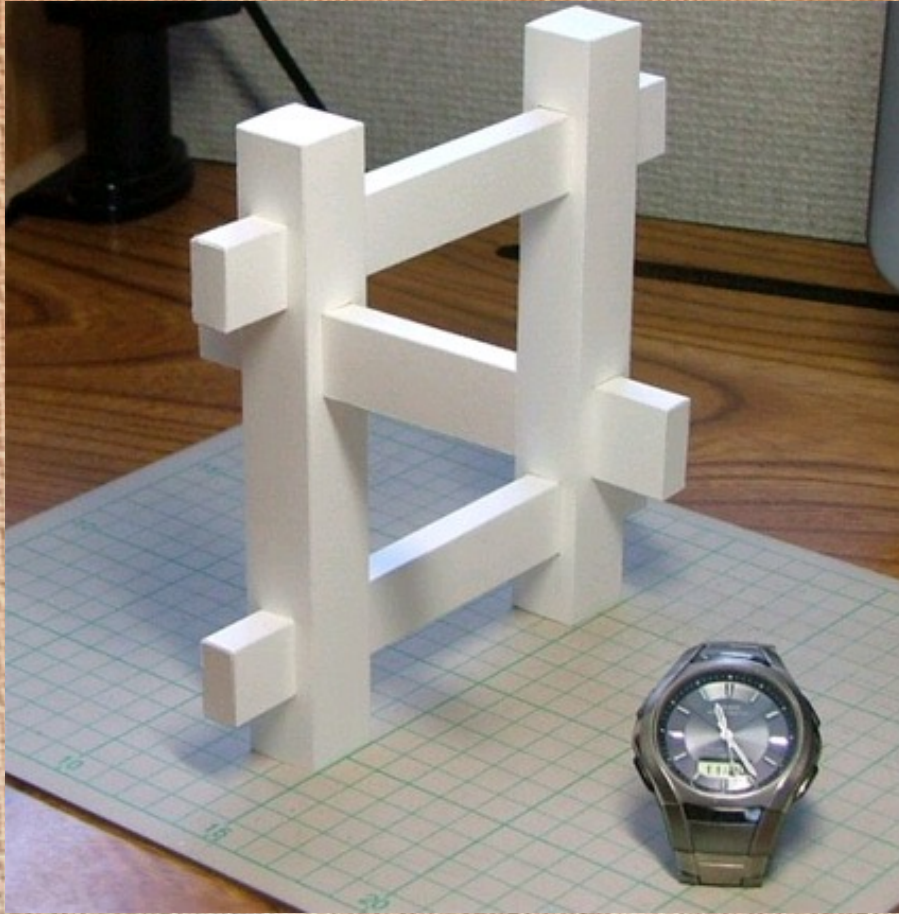
Touch

Truth: Is it real, is it true?



The most powerful sense is?



- Biblically, NOT Sight
- It is the most Powerful Physical Sense. It connects the physical world very powerfully with our brains. AND THAT IS THE CHRISTIANS PROBLEM. It can be deceived!

Romans 10:17 So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.

Hearing Is Our Most Powerful Sense

Because it connects with



- 1. Our Mind, more than our physical body
- 2. Our Faith Organ, which is our imagination.
We can with our mind “see” things that do not have a physical existence.

2 Corinthians 5:7 (For we walk by faith, not by sight:)

Evidence of things not directly sensed



Hebrews 11:3

Through faith we understand that the worlds were framed by the word of God, so that things which are seen were not made of things which do appear.

How Did Adam Gain Knowledge?

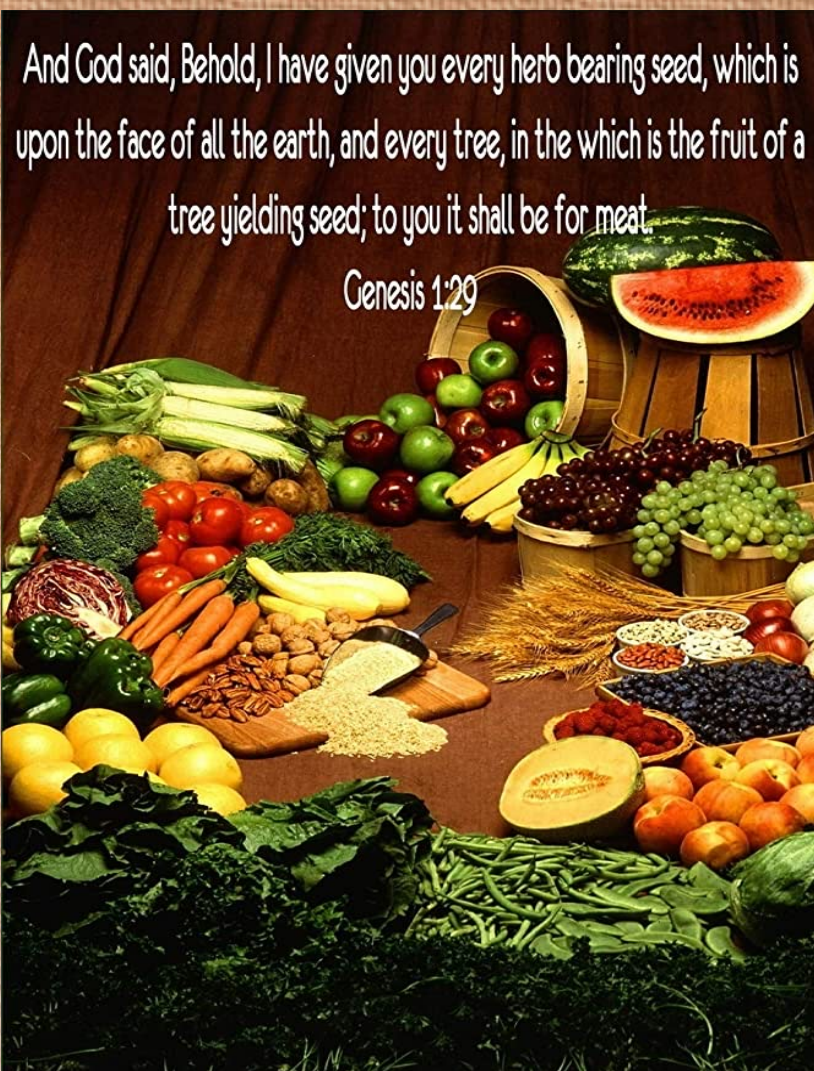


- A Soul; Interlocked with

THE ONLY Physical Words he “ate” *came from the seed God planted!*



Genesis 1:29 ¶ And God said, Behold, I have given you every herb **bearing seed**, which is upon the face of all the earth, and every tree, in the which is the fruit of a tree **yielding seed**; to you it shall be for meat.

THE ONLY Knowledge Words he HEARD



"But he answered and said, It is written, Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceedeth out of the mouth of God."

Matthew 4:4 (KJV)

Came from God through
the spirit covering!

- Deuteronomy 8:3that he might make thee know that man doth not live by bread only, but by **every word that proceedeth out of the mouth of the LORD** doth man live.

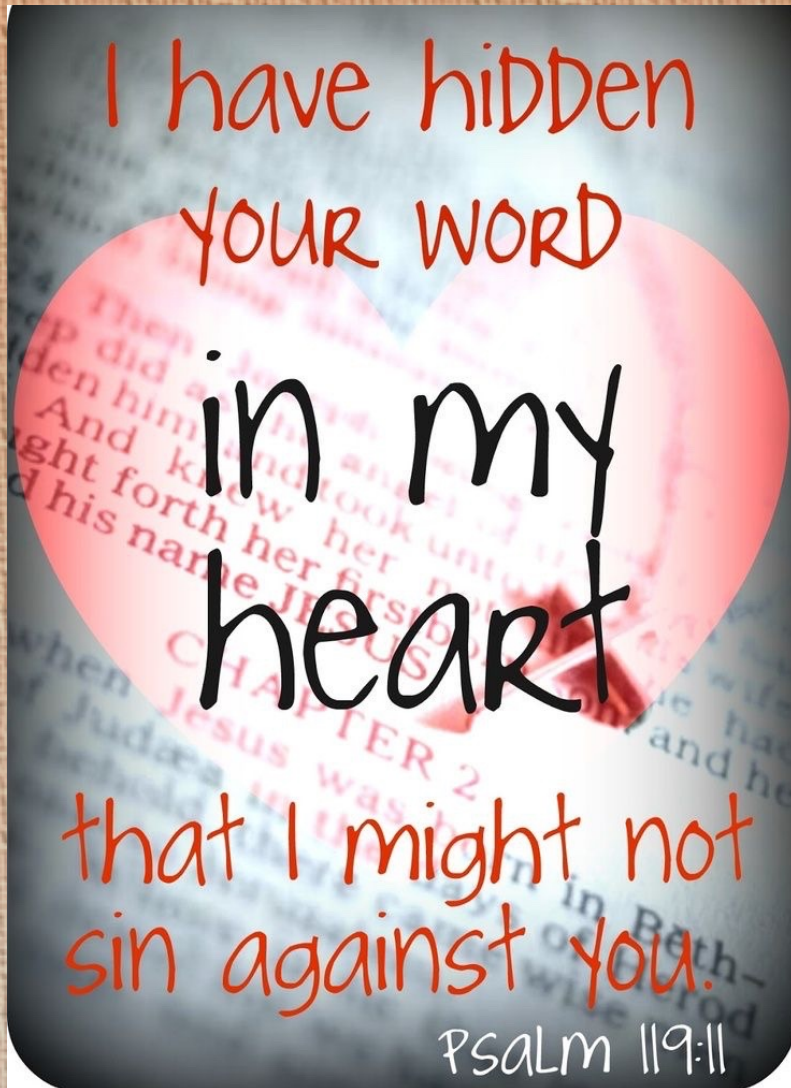
What about the other Senses? Especially Sight,

“Knowledge from God”



Before he ate of the tree of the knowledge of Good and Evil, The only knowledge of reality Man had was from God through the Spirit covering or from the seed of the planted word!

“Knowledge from God”



Before he ate of the tree of the knowledge of Good and Evil, **The only knowledge of reality Man had was from God** through the Spirit covering or from the seed of the planted word!

A baby is protected by the womb's covering. The baby's reality is the warmth and protection of the womb. It knows only what the womb provides. It's fed through the placenta. Which filters most of the harmful substances

“Knowledge from God”



- The proof of this is that they could not before they sinned “see” or be aware that they were naked.
- Genesis 2:25 And they were both naked, the man and his wife, and were not ashamed.

Knowledge of God



- Man's interface to the world was through **the spirit covering**. And therefore was by faith
- Hebrews 11:1 ¶ Now faith is the substance of things hoped for,
- the evidence of things not seen.

“The words...They are spirit...They are Life”

John 6:63 It is the spirit that quickeneth; the flesh profiteth nothing: the words that I speak unto you, they are spirit, and they are life.

Gods word(the logos) was mans original spirit covering.

Isaiah 30:1 ¶Woe to the rebellious children, saith the LORD, that take counsel, but not of me; and that cover with a covering, but not of my spirit, that they may add sin to sin:

The Death Mechanism

Eve listened to another's word Instead of the Logos



- Romans 10:17 So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.
- Bad faith, beliefs, religions, also come by hearing.
- This happens when the word is not from the Logos the spirit/mind of God
- By listening, having “faith” in another’s word, the spirit covering slowly began to STOP filtering her senses.

The Death Mechanism



After Eve believed in ANOTHER WORD,

- She ate of the tree and gave also to Adam. The tree then gave them knowledge outside of Gods word (the spirit covering)
- The Logos spirit covering left them(died to them) when there faith in its covering power was know Judged by their own independent knowledge
- There faith could no longer Make real (actualize) the spirit realm.

The Death Mechanism Revealed as Unbelief



Genesis 2:17 But of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, thou shalt not eat of it: for in the day that thou eatest thereof thou shalt surely die.

Because they were babies, their faith was not strong enough to sustain belief in their spiritual covering. When their previously filtered physical senses told them they were naked, they could no longer see the covering of light.

God withdrew his holy, life-giving spirit

- Job 34:14 if he gather unto himself his spirit and his breath;
- 15 All flesh shall perish together, and man shall turn again unto dust.



- The Knowledge of Good And Evil is
- Receiving “a word” but not from God
- Choosing Faith in our senses
- In other words FAITH IN OURSELVES
- FAITH IN OUR OWN JUDGEMENT



Matthew 3:11 I indeed baptize you with water unto repentance: but he that cometh after me is mightier than I, whose shoes I am not worthy to bear: he shall baptize you with the Holy Ghost, and with fire:

FAITH REBORN

- WHEN JESUS LEFT HE PROMISED
- TO SEND THE COMFORTER THE HOLY SPIRIT. “YET NOT ANOTHER”
- **1 Peter 1:23** Being born again, not of corruptible seed, but of incorruptible, **by the word of God**, which liveth and abideth for ever.
